Certificate Regarding 342(b) Notice

Pursuant to §521(a)(1)(B)(iii)(I) of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005, the attorney for the debtor, in a case where the individual is a debtor whose debts are primarily consumer debts, is required to file a certificate with the court indicating that he/she delivered to the debtor the notice required by section 342(b). The filing of this certificate in CM/ECF is completed as follows:

- 1. Select **Other** from the Bankruptcy Events menu.
- 2. Enter the appropriate case number and click [Next].
- 3. Select the "Certification Regarding Notice to Debtor" filing event. Click [Next].
- 4. If applicable, indicate the joint filing with another attorney. Click [Next] to proceed.
- 5. Select the appropriate debtor(s) as the party filer. Click [Next].
- 6. Attach the PDF copy of the Certificate Regarding 342(b) Notice. Click [Next].
- 7. CM/ECF will prompt you to indicate the appropriate filer. Click the "Attorney for Debtor" radio-button. Click [Next] to proceed.
- 8. Click [Next] to continue.
- 9. Review the final docket text; if no modifications are needed, click [Next] to complete the filing.
- 10. CM/ECF will now display a Notice of Electronic Filing for the filed Certificate Regarding 342(b) Notice.
