


DAY OF DEATH

WEEK OF DEATH





WHO IS DYING?

- > Chronically homeless men
- Live on streets, avoid shelters
- > Vulnerable to injury, trauma, hypothermia
- > High utilization of EW and Detox
- > EtOH use, with levels commonly >3500
- Chronic mental illness with multiple SI/SA
- Several major medical illnesses
