CHAPTER 5: DATA BASE DICTIONARY

5-1. General Description. Pages 5-2 through 5-19 of this Chapter list, by Repeating Group, each data element contained within the FORMS/CPD Data Base structure. Also provided are data element size and indications of such data element characteristics as alpha/ numeric, dollar (numeric) amounts, date values and key/nonkey. If neither key nor nonkey is specified, the data element is considered key. Beginning on Page 5-20, a definition for each Headquarters mandated data element has been provided along with any appropriate codes, values, etc. Please note a few minor differences in definitions for certain data elements as they pertain to CDBG Grants as opposed to Action Grants, i.e. Grant Amount Approved (C254). If a data element has been defined in Chapter 5, it should be considered "Headquarters mandated" and must be maintained on the data base. All other data elements are considered "optional" by Headquarters. Each Region's reporting requirements regarding optional data element is at the discretion of the respective Regional Administrator.

 - Principal benefit to low- and moderate-income persons;
 - Prevention or elimination of slums and blight;
 - Needs of a particular urgency.

In addition, this code shall be used when making a determination that the grantee's use of funds as a whole principally benefits low and moderate income persons. Do not use this code when referring to basic eligibility of activities under Sections 570.201 through 570.207 of the regulations.

- HAP Housing Assistance Plan The code indicating monitoring of the grantee for implementation of its Housing Assistance Plan. See Chapter 7 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4.
- CPA Citizen Participation The code indicating monitoring grantee compliance with applicable citizen participation requirements and includes review of complaints.

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ELI Eligibility of Activities The code indicating monitoring for eligibility of activities being carried out with Federal assistance.

- FEO Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity The code indicating a limited review of FHEO requirements by the CPD Representative. Codes for FHEO Field Office monitoring findings, concerning determinations of non-compliance with civil rights requirements, are described in the FHEO Data Base Dictionary.
- MBE Minority Business Enterprise The code used when monitoring minority business participation in grantee contracts.
- ACT Accountability The code indicating complete accountability monitoring. - RLC Relocation The code used for the in-depth monitoring reviews conducted by the Specialist discussed in HUD Handbook 1373.1 REV-1, Relocation and Real Estate Monitoring.

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- REL Relocation The code indicating the limited relocation reviews discussed in Section 3, Chapter 12 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4.
- RMI Relocation The code used for mail-in relocation reviews conducted by the Specialist as described in chapter 4 of HUD Handbook 1373.1 REV-1, Relocation and Real Estate

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Monitoring

- AQL Acquisition The code indicating monitoring for limited property acquisition reviews as discussed in Section 3, chapter 12 of HUD Handbook 6509.2, REV-4.
- ACQ Acquisition The code used for the in-depth acquisition review conducted by the Specialist described in HUD Handbook 1373.1 REV-1, Relocation and Real Estate Monitoring.
- AMI Acquisition The code used for the mail-in acquisition monitoring conducted by the Specialist as described in chapter 4 of HUD Handbook 1373.1, Relocation and Real Estate Monitoring.
- REH Rehabilitation The code used when monitoring of block grant funded rehabilitation or the Rental Rehabilitation Program is conducted by the Rehabilitation Specialist. See chapter 6 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4.
- RHB Rehabilitation The code used for monitoring of block grant funded rehabilitation programs or the Rental Rehabilitation program when conducted by the CPD Representative. See chapter 6 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4.
- 312 Section 312 Rehabilitation Loans The code used when monitoring of Section 312 funded rehabilitation is conducted by the Rehabilitation Specialist as discussed in chapter 6 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4. The code 312 is generally entered using the grant number for either the grantee's CDBG program or Urban Homesteading Program as appropriate.

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- ENV Environment The code used when the CPD Representative conducts monitoring of those areas covered by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and related statutes, Executive Orders, criteria, standards, policies and regulations. Monitoring by CPD Representatives of the grantee's implementation of the Flood Insurance Purchase requirements set forth in 24 CFR 570.605 shall be covered by code FDP. See HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4, chapter 12.
- EVR Environment The code used when the Environmental Officer conducts monitoring of those areas covered by

the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, and related statutes, Executive Orders, criteria, standards, policies and regulations. See HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4, chapter 9.

- FDP Flood Disaster Protection The code used when monitoring grantee compliance with Sections 102 (a) and 202 (a) of the Flood Disaster Protection Act as described in Section 1 of Chapter 12 of HUD Handbook 6509.4 Rev-4.
- 108 Section 108 Loan Guarantees The code used when monitoring Section 108 assistance to entitlement grantees for compliance with program regulations and the security requirements contained in Section 108 contracts.
- URR Urban Renewal The code used when monitoring repayment obligations for closed urban renewal projects.
- MON Monitoring The code indicating review of the State Block Grant program to determine whether the state adequately conducted reviews of its recipients.
- TIM Timeliness The code indicating monitoring of the State Block Grant program to determine whether the state distributed the funds in a timely manner.
- DIS Distribution The code indicating monitoring of the State Block Grant program to determine whether the state distributed the funds in conformance with the method described in its final statement.
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- GCS Grant Closeout System The code used when reviewing and sampling the state system to ensure closeouts on a timely basis.
- AUM Audits Management The code used when reviewing the state's procedures to comply with OMB Circular A-128.
- ECO Economic Development The code used when monitoring the state's system for selection and management of economic development assistance to for-profit entities.
- FUN Fundability of Activities The code used when reviewing and sampling the system the State has in place to insure that each activity funded is eligible under Section 105(a) and that each activity meets a national

objective.

- ROR Review of Recipients The code indicating field office review of recipient local governments for the state CDBG program.
- PER Performance The code indicating Action Grant Performance. The code shall be used when monitoring to insure that the benefits claimed by UDAG grantees, which are incorporated into Exhibits A to F of the grant agreement, are actually occurring. Such benefits include level of new private investment, jobs, housing, taxes, in lieu payments and energy savings.
- XXX The code indicating any other areas monitored, such as the requirements for the handicapped, lead-based paint, etc.

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Monitoring Target Date for Response C442 Screen C11A

The date in the monitoring letter that indicates response is due from the grantee. If the grantee was found to be in compliance/conformance in the area monitored, the element is blank, thus indicating no response required. Each negative conclusion shall be given a target date. If the finding was corrected on-site, the Target Date and the Monitoring Finding Cleared Date (C459) shall be the same as Date of Monitoring Visit (C439). Different findings may have different target response dates or all findings may have a single target response date. For "Program Area Monitored" codes AMI and RMI, this is the deadline by which the grantee has been requested to submit information for the in-house review.

Monitoring Date of Grantee Response C444 Screen C11A

The date the letter, documentation, etc. from the grantee is received in the Field Office. The conclusion number for each finding to which the grantee has responded is shown in Monitoring Conclusion Number (C438).

Monitoring-HUD Response Date. C445, C447, C449, C451, C453, C455, C457 Screen C11A

The date of the HUD letter, Memo-To-File (following telephone call) etc., responding to the information/documentation submitted by the grantee. HUD response date is used when information is not acceptable. The finding is cleared by entering the date of the HUD letter, memo etc. in Monitoring

Finding Cleared Date (C459). If the information is not acceptable, up to seven (7) response dates for each finding will be maintained in the system if needed to clear the finding. If the finding is not cleared after seven response dates, the system will retain the seven latest entries.

Monitoring-Retarget Date. C446, C448, C450, C452, C454, C456, C458 Screen C11A

The new date established for grantee response to each finding which is unresolved and past due. Under this system each finding may be assigned the same or a different retarget date. The data base will automatically retain up to seven (7) retarget dates per finding. If the finding is not cleared after seven retarget dates, the system will retain the seven latest entries.

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Monitoring Finding Cleared Date C459 Screen C11A

The date of the HUD letter (or other communication) to the grantee clearing/closing a monitoring finding or applying a sanction. The element is entered following signature of the letter to the grantee.

Monetary Finding C462 Screen 11B

A "Y" for yes and an "N" for no to indicate whether the grantee was advised to repay funds as a result of a finding.

Finding Action Code C463 Screen 11B

For those non-monetary findings (i.e. those with an "N" entered in C462) one of the following codes indicates the action the field office requested of the grantee to resolve the finding. Only one code is entered per finding. However, if as a result of grantee response, another action is taken, the latest action code should be entered. Select the code which most closely describes the action taken. The codes are:

- S progress schedules requested
- P institute reversed procedures
- A no longer accept certification and additional assurance will be required
- R reprogram funds
- D suspend disbursement for a specific activity

Date Final Action C464 Screen C11B

For monetary findings, the date upon which the final action was taken regarding the request for payment for that finding, e.g. the date the grantee repaid the line of credit; the date a letter was sent to the grantee indicating the finding was resolved in favor of the grantee and payment was not required; the date of the letter reducing the grant. This date should not be entered until all the dollars in Final Finding Amount (C465) have been accounted for.

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Final Finding Amount C465 Screen 11B

The final amount the grantee has been advised to repay for the finding. This should be the total of the entries in Return of Grant (C466), Paid to U.S. Treasury (C468), Amount Resolved Without Payment (C469), Amount Reduced (C470) and Amount Unresolved (C471).

Date of Repayment Letter C467 Screen C11B

Date of the letter to the grantee advising the repayment of funds as a result of a finding from an on-site monitoring visit a performance report review, a drawdown analysis of the line of credit, litigation, citizen's complaint or HAP review. This date is not necessarily the same as date HAP reviewed, date of monitoring letter or date GPR review completed. This field is not changed to reflect subsequent letters requesting repayment

Condition Finding Number C475 Screen C12

Each of the grantee's contract conditions is given a unique condition number The letter 'C' is used in the first space. The last digit of the fiscal year in which the contract was signed is noted in the second space. The last three spaces are used to record numbers in sequential order for each condition in the contract. The first contract condition each year begins with the number 001

Condition Date of Letter to Grantee C476 Screen C12

The date the Field Office Manager or designee signed the approval letter for the grant being conditioned. This element

shall be completed when the letter is dispatched.

Program Area Conditioned C477 Screen C12

The code indicating the area that was the subject of the contract condition. Each program area code may be used as many times as needed. Valid codes include:

PRP Program Progress The code indicating progress in carrying out either the program as a whole or any specific project that has been conditioned. Also included in this code are conditions relating to capacity to carry out the program and the grantee's management system (excluding financial management).

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- MFP Program Benefit/Maximum Feasible Priority The code indicating those conditions relating to one or more of the national objectives of the Act as defined in 24 CFR 570.200 (a)(2):
 - Principal benefit to low- and moderate-income persons;
 - Prevention or elimination of slums and blight;
 - Needs of a particular urgency.

This code is not used when referring to basic eligibility of activities under Sections 570.201 through 570.207 of the regulations.

- HAP Housing Assistance Plan The code indicating the grantee has been conditioned regarding the acceptability of its proposed HAP. (See Section 570.306 of the Regulations).
- HAI Housing Assistance Plan Implementation The code indicating the grantee has been conditioned regarding performance or progress in meeting the goals of a prior years Housing Assistance Plan. (See Section 570.306 of the Regulations and Chapter 6 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4).
- ELI Eligibility of Activities The code indicating conditioning of eligibility of activities being carried out with block grant funds. (See Sections 570.201 through 207 of the regulations).
- TIM Timeliness The code indicating conditioning under the

State Block Grant program relating to whether the State distributed the funds in a timely manner.

ENV Environment The code used when conditioning those areas covered by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and related statutes, Executive Orders, criteria, standards, policies and regulations. (See HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV 4, Chapter 9).

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- FEO Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity The code indicating when the grantee has been conditioned for noncompliance with the FHEO requirements as the result of a FHEO monitoring finding.
- PER Performance The code indicating Action Grant performance. The code shall be used when conditioning to insure that the benefits claimed by UDAG grantees, which are incorporated into Exhibits A to F of the grant agreement, are actually occurring. Such benefits include level of new private investment, jobs, housing, taxes, in lieu payments and energy savings.
- PRC Procurement Procedures The code indicating the grant has been conditioned for those areas relative to the procurement standards prescribed in Part 85.
- ALL Allowable Costs The code indicating conditioning the allowability of costs incurred by the grantee using program funds under Part 85.
- LAB Labor Standards The code indicating grantee compliance with the Davis-Bacon Act, Copeland Act, and Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, as discussed in chapter 11 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4 and the Federal Labor Standards and Compliance Handbook 1344.1 REV-1.
- PPM Personal Property Management The code used when conditioning the grantee's personal property management standards for compliance with Part 85.
- SUB Subrecipients The code used when conditioning the grantee's system for insuring that subrecipients and operating agencies adhere to all Federal management and administrative standards.
- FMG Financial Management The code indicating conditions relating to grantee compliance with the financial

management requirements of Part 85. Also used when conditioning and regarding use of program income, status of audits and audit findings.

FDP Flood Disaster Program The code indicating conditions relating to grantee compliance with Sections 102(a) and 202(a) of the Flood Disaster Protection Act.

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- MON Monitoring The code indicating the conditioning of the State Block Grant program regarding adequacy of state reviews of its recipients.
- DIS Distribution The code indicating the conditioning of the State Block Grant program regarding the distribution of funds in conformance with the method described in its final statement.
- CPA Citizen Participation The code indicating the grant has been conditioned for either the conformance of the grantee's citizen participation plan to the regulations, or implementation of the plan. (See 570.303 of the regulations and Chapter 8 of HUD Handbook 6509.2 REV-4).
- REL Relocation The code indicating the subject matter of the condition is relocation. (See HUD Handbook 1373.1 REV 1, Relocation and Real Estate Monitoring).
- ECO Economic Development The code used when conditioning the State regarding the state's system for selection and management of economic development assistance to for-profit entities.
- AUM Audits Management The code used when conditioning the State regarding the state's procedures to comply with OMB Circular A 128.
- GCS Grant Closeout System The code used when conditioning the State regarding the state's system to ensure closeouts on a timely basis.
- FUN Fundability of Activities The code used when conditioning the State regarding the systems that the State has in place to insure that each activity funded is eligible under Section 105(a) and that each activity meets a national objective.
- ACQ Acquisition The code indicating the subject of the condition is real estate acquisition. (See HUD Handbook

1373.1 REV-1. Relocation and Real Estate Monitoring).

RHB Rehabilitation The code used for conditioning of block grant funded rehabilitation programs.

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XXX The code indicating any other areas, including special conditions relating to the requirements for the handicapped, lead-based paint, etc. Enter only those other conditions appearing in item 10 of the Funding Approval, HUD 7082.

Dollar Amount Conditioned C478 Screen C12

The dollar amount conditioned for each contract condition. In those cases where the entire grant is conditioned, enter the amount of the entire grant. If the entire grant is conditioned by more than one finding, the entire grant amount is indicated on each condition. Where funds have not been conditioned, the element is blank.

Condition Target Date for Grantee Response C479 Screen C12

The date in the contract condition indicating that the response is due from the grantee. Different contract conditions may have different target response dates, or they may all have a single target date. The date shall be indicated for each contract condition. In the event a target date was not appropriate for the specific condition and therefore none was established, this element should be left blank.

If the grantee has been required to submit quarterly or periodic reports, enter the first date that has been established for a grantee response. The balance of the reporting dates shall be entered under Retarget Date.

Condition Date of Grantee's Response C480 Screen C12

The date grantee's response is received in the Field Office. Each contract condition to which the grantee has responded must have an entry in the Condition Finding Number (C475). Condition - HUD Response Date. C481, C483, C485, C487, C489, C491, C493 Screen C12

The date of the HUD letter to the grantee responding to the information/documentation submitted by the grantee. If the information submitted is acceptable, the condition is cleared by entering the HUD response date in Date Condition Cleared (C495). If the information is not acceptable, the grantee is provided a retarget date for each open condition which is past due. The HUD Response Date shall be entered when the letter is dispatched.

Condition - Retarget Date. C482, C484, C486, C488, C490, C492, C494 Screen C12

The new date(s) established for grantee action for each open contract condition. Under this system each condition may be assigned the same or a different retarget date. The data base will automatically retain up to seven (7) retarget dates per condition, if needed. If the contract condition is not cleared after seven retarget dates, the system will retain the seven latest entries.

Date Condition Cleared C495 Screen C12

The date of the HUD letter to the grantee clearing/closing a contract condition or applying a sanction which closes the condition. This element is input following signature of the letter to the grantee.

Date Grantee Performance Report Due C601 Screen C2B

System generated. Ninety days after Program Year Start Date (C50). Field Office should override when a waiver of due date is granted.

Date Corrected Grantee Performance Report Due C604 Screen C2B

An entry indicates the original Grantee Performance Report (GPR) submitted was incomplete or incorrect. The date that was established by the Field Office for submission of a corrected GPR.

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Date Corrected GPR Received C605 Screen C2B

The date the correct/complete Grantee Performance Report (GPR)

was received by the Field Office

Target Date for Grantee Response C609 Screen C2B

The date by which a grantee must respond to HUD's determination of apparently unsatisfactory Grantee Performance Report (GPR) performance. Note that when the monitoring of a CDBG Entitlement grantee is scheduled within 45 days of completion of the substantive GPR review, determinations of apparently unsatisfactory performance shall be handled under the monitoring tracking system

Date Grantee Responded C611 Screen C2B

The date the grantee responded to the Field Office's notification of apparently unsatisfactory performance.

Date GPR Review Completed C612 Screen C2B

The date when a review of the Grantee Performance Report (GPR) has been completed and a letter has been sent to a grantee identifying any substantive problems or otherwise identifying the results of the substantive review.

Combination UC/MC Code C961 Screen C4C

A code C indicates that a metropolitan city or urban county has elected to be combined.

Grant Allocation C1005 Screen n/a

Headquarters input. The amount allocated to units of government and states by HUD Headquarters in accordance with formulas required by the Emergency Shelter Grant program. Funds allocated by HUD to a State are passed on to units of local government or to private nonprofit organizations approved by the unit of local government.

Date CHAP Due C1012 Screen C4G

Date by which the Field Office must receive the Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan (CHAP).

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Date CHAP Received C1016 Screen C4G

Date the Field Office receives the Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan (CHAP).

Date CHAP Approved C1017 Screen C4G

Date the Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan (CHAP) is approved.

Date CHAP Disapproved C1018 Screen C4G

Date the Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan (CHAP) is disapproved.

State Reason Declined Code. C1020 Screen C4G

This field reflects the reason why a state declines to develop an application for Emergency Shelter Grant program funds. The Field Office project officer should consult with Headquarters staff in determining which code should be assigned.

Date Application Due C1025 Screen C4G

The date by which an Emergency Shelter Grant application from an eligible unit of government must be received by the Field Office.

Date Application Received. C1030 Screen C4G

The date on which an Emergency Shelter Grant application from an eligible unit of government is received by the Field Office.

Reason Not Applied C1035 Screen C4G

A code used to indicate why a unit of government declines to submit an application for Emergency Shelter Grant program funds. Code "A" indicates unit of government declined the grant.

Date Application Approved C1040 Screen C4G

The date entered on the approval letter, ESGP Grant Agreement, and ESGP Funding Approval Form.

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Date Application Disapproved C1045 Screen C4G

The date the application is disapproved. This is the date of the letter informing the applicant that the application was disapproved.

Grant Condition Code C1050 Screen C4G

A code which indicates the subject matter of any special

conditions which were imposed on the grantee as part of the grant agreement.

A - Environmental

- B Other
- C Both

Reason Not Approved. C1055 Screen C4G

A code indicating why an Emergency Shelter Grant application was not approved.

Missed Target Code C1060 Screen C4G

A code indicating why the processing of the Emergency Shelter Grant program application was not completed within the required review period. The following codes have been defined:

A - incomplete application submittedB - eligibility issues needed to be resolved.

The Field Office project officer should consult with Headquarters staff if another code should be assigned.

Date of Grant Execution C1065 Screen C4G

The date the recipient executes the original Grant Agreement for the Emergency Shelter Grant program. This is the date on the signature page of that Grant Agreement.

Grant Amount Approved C1070 Screen C4G

For states and other grantees funded directly by HUD, the amount of funds approved as shown on the Emergency Shelter Grant Program 'Funding Approval' Form.

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Date State Subgrants Due C1075 Screen C4H

Deadline for a state to distribute its Emergency Shelter grants among recipients in accordance with the state's procedures.

Date State Subgrants Awarded C1080 Screen C4H

Date a state completes the activity of awarding all its Emergency Shelter grant funds to recipients.

State Grant Amount Returned C1085 Screen C4H

The amount of a state Emergency Shelter Grant which was not awarded by the state to recipients by the deadline, and which is being returned to HUD for reallocation among other recipients.

Amount Not Obligated C1090 Screen C4H

The amount of Emergency Shelter Grant which is not committed to projects by the deadline date for completing such commitments

Date Interim Report Received C1095 Screen C4H

Date the interim Emergency Shelter Grant financial report is received in the Field Office.

Date Annual Report Received C1100 Screen C4H

Date the Annual Performance Report is received in the Field Office.

Date Funds Obligated C1145 Screen C4H

Date when all ES grant funds have been obligated to activities

Reason funds Not Obligated C1150 Screen C4H

A code summarizing the reason why a recipient did not complete the commitment of grant funds to activities by the deadline for doing so

Number of Subprojects C1155 Screen C4H

The number of separate activities actually carried out by a recipient.

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
