Voting Information

In order to register to vote, you must be a United States citizen, a resident of Washington state, and at least 18 years of age.

How to register:

You can register at any public school, government office, library or when you renew your driver's license.

Absentee Ballots:

You can request an absentee ballot by calling or writing to the county elections officer or auditor. You can request to be a permanent absentee voter and vote from home all of the time.

If you have moved:

You can call your county auditor or elections officer and they will transfer your registration or send you a new registration form.


