The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is completing a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Report for the Green Lane Reservoir. The current report is significantly different from the draft report that you may be familiar with. The draft report that was public noticed did not represent any impact to NPDES point source dischargers, such as your facility. However, since the revised report requires reductions in phosphorus contributions from your facility, the Department is providing this opportunity for your review.

Any requirements in the final TMDL for reductions in phosphorus loads from NPDES point source dischargers will be implemented in your next permit renewal. This notice is being given to inform you in advance of this proposed new requirement, to solicit your comments on the TMDL, and to allow time for you to develop a plan to ensure compliance with the new phosphorus limit prior to it being placed in your NPDES permit. Comments received within 30 days of the date of this letter will be considered in finalizing the TMDL report.
