CHANGE NOTICE-RESCISSION

- 1. Purpose. In compliance with paragraph 6(h) of Directive OPM-1, transmittal number 930 and dated April 9, 2008, this notice rescinds INE-32, Oversight Procedures for States' Implementation of the Applicant/Violator System Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). This directive addressed OSM procedures and responsibilities for ensuring that operation of the Applicant/Violator System and maintenance of the system's information records by States with approved regulatory programs met OSM's standards for effective and efficient operation.
- 2. <u>Summary of Changes.</u> Reviews of Directive INE-32 and the underlying MOU found that many provisions of the MOU are no longer relevant due to OSM regulatory changes. The remaining relevant provisions of the MOU have been adopted into OSM regulations. States' will amend their programs to be no less effective than the Federal program with respect to these new rules. OSM procedures and responsibilities for implementing these regulations are to be incorporated into other Directives.
