#### **Report Highlights:**

On September 19, Taiwan resumed its rice tender for the 2007 unfilled quota for public sector imports and successfully awarded 4,200 tons of long grain milled rice on a global basis (4,830 tons on brown). Taiwan unfilled 2007 quota now stands at 28,207 tons down from 32,037 from tons when the last tender for public sector imports was held on May 23rd.

# Results from September 19<sup>th</sup> and Previous May 23<sup>rd</sup> Rice Tender for 2007 Unfilled Quota for Public Sector Imports

Taiwan unfilled 2007 quota now stands at 28,207 tons down from 32,037 tons when the last tender for public sector imports was held on May 23rd.

### **September 19th Tender Results:**

## GF4-960-234-4 for 1,000 tons short grain milled glutinous rice (1,150 tons on brown) for 11/31/2008 delivery-on a global basis

The quota is transferred from unfilled Australia CSQ.

Two bidders representing Vietnamese rice participated in the bidding. Their tender did not succeed because the submitted rice samples didn't pass the tender specifications mainly from too much broken and/or damaged kernels.

# GF4-960-245-4 for 1,000 tons milled short grain glutinous rice (1,150 tons on brown) for 12/31/2008 delivery-on a global basis

The quota is transferred from US CSQ.

Two bidders participated in the bidding. One representing Vietnamese rice bidding for 630 tons who failed the tender because of quality issues, while the other representing U.S. rice bided for 410 tons didn't succeed because offered bid prices exceeded the ceiling price, with the lowest bid at NT\$35,999/mt or \$1,117.29/mt down from the original bid of NT\$36,499/mt or \$1,132.81/mt.

# GF4-960-266-3 for 4,200 tons long grain milled fragrant rice (4,830 tons on brown) for 12/31/2008 delivery- on a global basis

The quota is GF4-960-266-2 for 3,200 tons and GF4-960-234-3 for 1,000 tons combined, which are transferred from Australia unfilled quotas.

Two bidders participated in the bidding. These two bidders all representing Thai rice and all bided for 4,200 tons. Taiwan successfully awarded the tender to one Thai rice importer at NT\$28,199/mt or \$875.20/mt.

(Exchange rate is NT\$32.22 to \$1, quoted 09/19/2008.)

### May 23rd Tender Results:

# GF4-960-227-3 for 3,000 tons Short/Medium grain milled rice (3,450 tons on brown) for 12/31/2008 delivery –US origin

The quota is GF4-960-227-2 for 2,000 tons and GF4-960-245-3 for 1,000 tons combined U.S. CSQ.

Taiwan tendered for 3,000 tons of U.S. origin short/medium grain milled rice for end year delivery. The tender failed due to offered bidding price exceeding the pre-set ceiling price by COA/AFA.

There was only one U.S. supplier participating in the bidding and offered a bidding price of NT\$39,196/mt or \$1,290.19/mt on a basis of DDP, Duty Paid Delivery.

(Exchange rate is NT\$30.38 to \$1, quoted by 05/23/2008.)
