USE OF A PHOTO ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM ON STATE HIGHWAYS.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of  
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Under the power of referendum, as vested in the Legislature, the  
4 following measure, relating to use of a photo enforcement system on state  
5 highways, is enacted to become valid as a law if approved by the voters and  
6 on proclamation of the Governor:

7 AN ACT

8 AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 6, ARIZONA REVISED  
9 STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 28-711; RELATING TO PHOTO  
10 ENFORCEMENT.

11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

12 Section 1. Title 28, chapter 3, article 6, Arizona  
13 Revised Statutes, is amended by adding section 28-711, to read;

14 28-711. Photo enforcement system; requirement; highways  
15 A PHOTO ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM SHALL BE USED ON STATE HIGHWAYS  
16 TO DETECT VIOLATORS OF THIS ARTICLE.

17 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters  
18 at the next general election as provided by article IV, part 1, section 1,  
19 Constitution of Arizona.
