AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR ESTABLISHMENT
OF A CRIME LABORATORY IN SOUTHERN ARIZONA.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: southern Arizona crime laboratory:
3 exemption; offset

4 A. The sum of \$15,700,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
5 in fiscal year 2007-2008 to the department of public safety for establishment
6 of a southern Arizona crime laboratory.

7 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
8 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
9 lapsing of appropriations.

10 C. Any federal monies provided to this state for establishing a
11 southern Arizona crime laboratory shall be used to offset the appropriation
12 made in subsection A of this section and the offset amount reverts to the
13 state general fund.
