AMENDING SECTION 13-708, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SENTENCING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-708, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 13-708. Consecutive terms of imprisonment

5 A. Except as otherwise provided by law, if multiple sentences of  
6 imprisonment are imposed on a person at the same time, the ~~sentence~~~~or~~  
7 sentences imposed by the court shall run consecutively unless the court  
8 expressly directs otherwise, in which case the court shall set forth on the  
9 record the reason for its sentence.

10 B. Notwithstanding subsection A, if a person is subject to an  
11 undischarged term of imprisonment and is sentenced to an additional term of  
12 imprisonment for ~~a felony~~ AN offense that is committed while the person is  
13 under the jurisdiction of the state department of corrections, the sentence  
14 imposed by the court shall run consecutively to the undischarged term of  
15 imprisonment.
