**AN ACT**

**AMENDING SECTION 13-2504, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ESCAPE.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-2504, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 13-2504. Escape in the first degree; classification

5 A. A person commits escape in the first degree by knowingly escaping  
6 or attempting to escape from custody or a juvenile secure care facility, A  
7 juvenile detention facility or an adult correctional facility by:

8 1. Using or threatening ~~the~~ TO use ~~of~~ physical force against another  
9 person; or

10 2. Using or threatening to use a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument  
11 against another person.

12 B. Escape in the first degree is a class 4 felony, and the sentence  
13 imposed for a violation of this section shall run consecutively to any  
14 sentence of imprisonment for which the person was confined, TO ANY  
15 CONFINEMENT IN A SECURE CARE FACILITY or to any term of community supervision  
16 for the sentence including probation, parole, work furlough or any other  
17 release.
