By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. The Telecommunications Access Policy Division has under consideration a Request for Waiver filed by Orleans Parish School District, New Orleans, Louisiana (Orleans Parish), seeking waiver of the September 30, 2004 deadline for the installation of non-recurring services for Funding Year 2003 of the schools and libraries universal service support program.<sup>1</sup> Upon review of the record, we find that SLD has approved Orleans Parish's request for an extension of the non-recurring services deadline.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, we dismiss Orleans Parish's Request for Waiver as moot.
