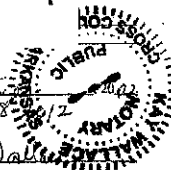

I am writing this letter in hopes that my story will help persuade the decision makers regarding the overturn of the Roe vs. Wade decision.

My name is Lee Ann Monty and at 20 years old I made the decision (with the "help" of others) to abort my child. This has proved to be an awful "choice", one that has had far worse consequences than I ever imagined possible. I sincerely hope this "choice" is no longer available to anyone.

My abortion experience was very traumatic and even writing about it now over 10 years later is very difficult and uncomfortable. Only with the help of God will be able to tell my story.

I was unmarried and barely 20 years old when I became pregnant. I was in a very unhealthy relationship that my parents did not approve of. They were supporting me financially as I was still in college. So their opinion carried a great weight in my life at the time. I loved them very much and never wanted to disappoint them in any way. Clearly when I discovered I was pregnant I knew they would be heart broken. I did not know what to do. I just pretended that it wasn't happening and passed from reality into sort of a denial. I continued living as normal as possible for as long as I could. Meanwhile my romantic relationship was getting worse and worse. My boyfriend knew about the pregnancy and wasn't pushing me either way. He had been responsible for 2 other girls' pregnancies, which resulted in abortion. He was casual about the idea of abortion but would have kept the baby if I wanted to. We were both very irresponsible, neither of us having very stable income or educations. I could not imagine (at that time) us becoming parents and successfully raising a child. One more "complication" in this situation is that we were an inter-racial couple and my parents "feared" for what the

child's life would be like. Having us for parents and being bi-racial didn't seem quite fair. I would like to add here that I think a bi-racial baby or any other baby is valuable, important, and precious. All babies are 100% worthy of life. After all God is the creator and giver of life. We are just stewards of his "little blessings".

Finally, it started becoming obvious something was going on with me. My parents became suspicious and the time came when I had to tell them my secret. Hiding this from my friends and family had taken its toll on me. I was reluctant to reveal the secret I had kept for so long. I was unknowingly becoming attached and protective of my unborn child.

I wanted only to tell my mom but when both my parents approached me together, I had no choice but to tell them both at the same time. They did not yell at me like I expected them to. They asked me what I was planning to do. I said I didn't know what to do. They instructed me to first find out how far along I was. Now I know why they needed to know that. My dad had already decided how to handle this "unfortunate" situation. We would just get rid of it. I was to have an abortion and that was final. Then life could just resume back to normal. Let me just say that did not happen, it never does for anyone that has an abortion. There are always consequences.

They made an appointment at some clinic for me to be examined. I refused to let either of them go back in the exam room with me. I did not inform the examining physician that abortion was even being contemplated. I don't know how far along I was that day but when he put the Doppler on my uterus, there was a distinct "noise". He excitedly said the sound I was asking about was the heartbeat and that I was carrying a healthy baby. I will never forget his words or the sound of my baby's heartbeat. From

that moment on I knew I loved my baby. I left there that afternoon with a positive pregnancy test in my hand and thoughts of baby in my head. I kept that pregnancy test hidden in my dresser drawer for a very long time. It was as if having that positive sign of life allowed me to hang on to the possibility of keeping a grasp on my unborn/aborted child. My parents drove me back to my apartment without much conversation. I told my parents that the doctor was unable to determine exactly how far along I was because I couldn't remember when I had my last menstrual period. I never told them about hearing the heartbeat. I knew they wouldn't share in the secret joy I was feeling.

My dad got the phone book and said to call this certain number and make an appointment as soon as they could get me in. I was sobbing so hard it took me several times to correctly dial the right number. It was so hard to speak, but forcing my voice I asked the women who answered the phone for an appointment. I did not accept the first one offered. I needed more time, time to think and time to spend with my child. Even though my dad was standing over me, I knew he would never know if I put it off, even if it was just for a few more days. I wanted to talk to my boyfriend but was not allowed by my parents. They would not let us see or speak to each other. From the time they got to my apartment and I told them I was pregnant I was never left alone, not even to sleep. I wanted him to go with me but they would not even let me tell him about the appointment. They lived about 2 hours by car from where I did. After the appointment was scheduled and I packed a few things I went back home with them where I stayed until I had physically recovered for the abortion.

It was almost 1 week from that day until the day of the procedure that murdered my innocent baby. I hardly stopped crying the whole week. I was so depressed, I could

hardly move. My mom slept in the same room with me at night, they were worried I would run away or maybe hurt myself. My parents tried to cheer me up and convince me this was a good idea. I really do believe my parents had what they thought was in my best interest at heart. My dad said to me one day before my appointment that this was necessary because he wanted my life to be perfect. He said, "I know you love this baby and want to protect it, but you are my baby and I love you and intent to protect you".

Unfortunately, the day I was dreading came, we got up very early for the drive. I had a 9 o'clock appointment. I do not believe I uttered a word for the 3-hour drive to the city where the clinic was located. I was too sad and confused, I could not believe this was happening to me, this just could not be my life, but it was happening and all too fast.

Before I knew it, we were parked and I was sitting in the waiting room. After the money was paid and the paperwork filled out, my name was called. My mom stood up first and helped me rise to my feet. I walked cautiously thru the door leading back to the "death chamber". We were seated before a lady who asked me some questions. Some of them my mom helped me answer. I started crying and she asked if I wanted to do this. I had so many questions but could not think. My mom answered her saying that I was just very emotional and this was defiantly best. She then asked if I wanted to be awake or asleep during the procedure. I said I did not under any circumstances want to be awake. I did not want to see, feel or remember anything.

She said "Ok, You will be asleep before they started". We were then escorted back to the waiting room. This time I paid attention. There were about 30 people sitting in various positions. Young and scared looking girls accompanied by either a parent or a boyfriend it appeared. As names were called and girls rose one by one disappearing

behind the door, others would emerge from the same door. They were in visible pain, their posture and face told. I began to squirm. I wanted out of there. Just then my name was called and I got up, then began to walk slowly to the lady who had called me from the open door.

As I followed her down the hall I noticed very distasteful art. Pencil like drawings of women's genitals hanging on the wall. She led me to a room where I was instructed to undress and put on the gown that was provided. She said the doctor would be in soon. As I got undressed I mentally noted everything about the room. It was cold, and scary, I was alone with my baby and I knew our time was short. I watched as the second hand slowly went around on the clock above the door. My hands rested on the little mound formed on my abdomen. I started to get very nervous and I began thinking of ways to get out of there. It was now or never. Never arrived.

My thoughts were interrupted when the door swung open and a tall man in white lab coat entered the room. Closely followed by two heavysset women. I wanted to speak; I had so many questions, "Like what is that thing?" What's that covered by the gray plastic bag?" But not really wanting to know. Even so, I was not allowed to speak. The doctor ordered me be quiet and listen to his demands. He said, "Scoot your butt down to the end of the table and lay back." I said that I would like to slow down, I was not sure I wanted to do this; I added this was my first opportunity to tell somebody. He then barked out, "Scoot down and lay back." I protested and said, Let's wait a minute, I don't want to..." Then the nurse pushed me back and the other nurse to the right grabbed my arm and started to place the IV into my arm. I began panicking and crying, I pleaded, "No!" I then heard a load noise start and felt the most excruciating pain. I began screaming that



they were hurting me and to get away from me. I had changed my mind, but they would not stop.

The nurse on my left then pinned my arm down between her and the table and was lying on my chest and covering my mouth with her ungloved hands. She said, "Stop screaming, you will scare the other girls!" I said, "No! Please stop. I want them to be scared." But it was too late. The pain I felt was the suctioning which was pulling my little one out of my body. Within a few more moments it was over. The anesthesia had taken effect but too late for my comfort, I saw, heard, and felt everything. Even more painful, I remember everything. It was a horrible, traumatic experience.

I was put in a "recovery" room, what a joke. When they put me in there, I was just waking up from the anesthesia. When I became conscious I started screaming again. The nurse who wheeled me in there told me to be quiet. She went and got my mother from the waiting room. My mom helped me lay down in a recliner. A few second later a girl rolled off her gurney and fell on the hard cold floor. My mom jumped up and hurried over to help her, as she now lied crying on the floor. I begin to look around and grasp what was around me. The only people in the room besides the ones who just underwent an abortion were my mom and one other mother. The room was wall to wall with gurneys and reclining chairs. Each one of them was occupied by girls, most of them laying in the fetal position; those that weren't, were balled up and rocking back and forth. Everyone was experiencing the same feelings: pain, nausea, heavy bleeding, and cramping. There were no nurses to attend to us. We were not treated as patients and even if we were to be, they did not have enough staff to accommodate post abortion women. While my mom was helping the other girl I started vomiting. The other mother rushed to the sink to get

paper towels or anything to help comfort me. She returned with a wet washcloth and a bedpan. She sat with me and as she held my hand she patted my forehead with the cool towel. My mom came back and thanked her. I would have thanked her, if I had had the strength.

The next hour or so was spent watching girls hobble out of the room and watching others be wheeled in just as I was. We re told to stay until the bleeding had slowed down. When you thought you were ready go, you had to find one of the few nurses who scurried from room to room, you could leave after showing her your bloody pad. If the nurse approved of the looks of the pad after asking how long you had been wearing it you were released to go.

Once I could muster up enough strength to walk again then I was able to leave that horrible place. I could not have walked out without assistance. I was escorted out with the help of my parents, my mom one side and my dad on the other. I limped out almost completely doubled over in pain. I have never spoken of this event with my parents. We never talked about what it was like as if I was ok with it. It is like it never happened. Almost like one Saturday that didn't exist. But I know it existed and I think in their minds somewhere they know it existed too.

That day was the beginning of many days of mental anguish. I was diagnosed with post-dramatic stress disorder and anxiety disorder. I have suffered many, many panic attacks. Experienced numerous unusual fears that are connected to the trauma I suffered as a result of the abortion. I have been through five years of professional counseling and to this day I am still on medication for anxiety and depression.

If I could give advice to anyone considering an abortion, which I have, I would say please, please, don't do it. Not only is it cruel and horrific for the baby, it is horrific for the mother as well. Abortion claims two victims every time. I still experience sadness and always will until I am united with my "lost" baby. God's mercy and forgiveness will allow me to hold him or her. Because I believe Jesus lives, I also believe my baby lives too.

I will beg the court to please make abortion illegal. Stop this unnecessary pain, torture, and murder. Maybe we don't have a cure for cancer or aids because the one who was destined to discover the cure was aborted. Just a thought...

Thank you for your time and consideration. I am hoping and praying you will make the right decision for life.

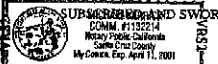



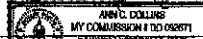

Before I give my story I must first say that without my Savior, Jesus Christ, I would not be able to share my story of what I have done. I have been redeemed by the precious blood of my Savior and that is the only thing enabling me to deal with my life.

I had a troubled teen life starting at the age of 13. The abuse that happened to me caused me to become completely out of control. I became pregnant 3 times in my teen years and all three times I aborted my precious babies. (I am sure that if I had the first baby there wouldn't have been a second and third pregnancy at that point in my life.) I had no support from any direction except being told I had to abort. Since I was a teenager living under my mother's roof- I felt I had no choice. I had no counseling before or after and I did not hear of any words of hope from anyone. Each experience with this brought me lower and lower in my life. I hated myself and I saw no reason for living. I had three suicide attempts and felt like a failure when it did not work. I began cutting myself just to watch myself heal. I dove into drugs, alcohol, and sex looking for comfort. Of course, I did not find it there. I felt horrible and eventually quit school because I did not feel that I deserved to have a life, let alone, enjoy it. I remember rubbing my tummy and thinking "wow, there's life in here" and then on the table at the abortion clinic I recall thinking of myself as a murderer. There was a poster on the ceiling as I was lying there about to have life ripped out of me that told me to "relax". How can you relax when you are about to end a life? How can you relax when a strange woman is holding your hand in assistance to the doctor who's killing your baby? How can you relax when everything in you is telling you this is wrong and everyone else around you is telling you "it's a choice and it's not a person yet"? How can you relax when you are nude from the waist down and a stranger is injecting a needle inside you to numb the "area"? How can you relax when you feel the cold steel of the murder weapon go up inside you and start jerking your insides around? How can you relax when you hear the sounds of life being ripped out of you? How are you supposed to relax when they put the life that was just inside of you in white see through container on the sink for you to see? How are you supposed to relax when the doctor and nurse say, "you did good" and your heart tells you the opposite? I did not relax the whole time. When they took me to the recovery room- it was like a waiting room and I could not bring myself to look at any of the other girls there. This is the room where they give you juice and graham crackers to "make you feel better". The memories are as if it just happened yesterday.

I am now a 32 year old woman who has not been able to have children with my husband of almost 13 years. The last abortion was a baby with my husband, who was then my boyfriend. I'm afraid I have destroyed my insides and my chances of becoming pregnant again. My childhood dream was to grow up, get married, and have a family. I used to pretend to be pregnant when I was a girl by stuffing sheets under my shirt. I just couldn't wait until I could get pregnant and experience the

miracle of life. Funny though, people used to tell me that I should want a career and all the trimmings that go with a career. My dream never changed. I simply wanted to be called a mom and a wife. I was going to be the best mom in the whole world too. I guess I will never know that now unless I adopt one day. Even then, it won't be quite the same. I never saw my pregnancy experience as it turned out. There will always be emptiness inside of me. I look in the faces of children I see and think, "I wonder if my children would've looked similar to that face". My life will never be the same and Christmas is especially hard because I got pregnant the first time around then. I broke down two Christmas's ago because there was something missing and that "something" was actually a someone! My children. I will never see the eyes of my unborn. I will never know what they would've become. I will never here my child say "mommy". I will never see my children walk, talk, or speak a sentence for the first time. My dreams were ripped out of my body and with it went a piece of my mind, heart, and soul. I am a mother of dead children and I never even saw their faces. I am sure their burial was in a lab where they were studied like rats and I am the one responsible for that.

My name is . I teach second grade English as a second language at a science and fine arts magnet school in Houston Independent School District. I have an adopted daughter who is expecting my first grandchild in February. I love my students and find each one holds such beauty and promise. I grieve for their missing classmates as I grieve for my child who never had an opportunity to draw a breath or be caressed.

I attended Southwest Texas State University after graduating from high school. In the winter of 1975, I knew that I was pregnant. I remembered the time when a Planned Parenthood presentation was given to all of the fourth grade students at D.D. Kirkland Elementary School in Oklahoma City. The lady who was showing us the video kept repeating abortion as the answer to all problems created by the "natural urge to enjoy sex." I remembered feeling awful seeing people's sex organs and seeing people having sex on the video while I was in a room with boys. I went home that day and asked my dad if abortion was OK. He thought about it a minute and then said, "If it will keep welfare babies off the welfare rolls, than it is a good thing." I didn't really understand what he was talking about but I got the message that he agreed with the Planned Parenthood lady that abortion was a mighty good thing, indeed.

I talked with the guy who had gotten me pregnant after I had confirmed my condition. He looked terrified and told me he never wanted to see me again. If I was pregnant, it was my problem and he didn't want to have anything to do with me or a baby. I went to the SWTSU infirmary and the doctor who saw me gave me a card with the address of the Planned Parenthood in Austin. The infirmary doctor seemed bored with the repetition of his task. He had a stack of Planned Parenthood cards in the examining room and wouldn't look at me when he handed me the card.

I drove myself to the Planned Parenthood in Austin the next day. I told the receptionist that I knew I was pregnant. She asked me if I had a credit card to pay for the "procedure" and I said I did. They did a pregnancy test and started talking about how they were going to help me with my problem before the test results were brought into the examining room by a technician.

The next thing I remember is lying on a table looking up at a man in a white coat. He was holding up a blood-covered, spoon-shaped knife looking thing connected with a hose to a big canister. I had my feet in the stirrups and remember feeling a horror and revulsion that convulsed my stomach and made me want to throw up. The next thing I remember is laying in a big room that was just wall to wall beds. I thought, "There must be 40 beds in here! How many of these "procedures" do these people do in a day?" A girl about my age offered me orange juice and I shakily dressed and drove myself home.

When I got to my apartment, I felt so wretched that I just went to bed. I don't know what happened for the next three days. Some friends came to check on me after I missed classes and found me in my bed soaked with urine and sweat. They took me to the infirmary where I was seen by the same doctor who had given me the card for Planned Parenthood. It was so weird because he acted like he was angry with me for having an abortion. He gave me an antibiotic shot and a prescription for an expensive horse-pill antibiotic.



I later found out that I had Pelvic Inflammatory Disease caused by the rampant infection in my abdomen. I married when I was 25 and spent the next eight years in the nightmare of infertility treatments, medications, and surgeries. Dr. Franklin in Houston was recommended to me as the best. He performed major surgery on me when I was 32. After the surgery, he said the abortionist had perforated my colon and the wall of my womb and the scar tissue was so hard and thick that he was not able to do enough in the 10 hour surgery to give us much hope of success in conceiving.

By God's grace we were chosen by a birth mother to adopt her little girl. We brought Catie Brookes home when she was three days old. We would have brought her home sooner but she had been scheduled to be aborted by saline abortion when she was six months old in the womb because her birth mother's doctor insisted the child had multiple handicaps. The people in the hospital just couldn't believe she was completely healthy. Catie was conceived as a result of rape. Her birth mother was 43 at the time. A mentally handicapped woman from a childhood head injury, she had to take Dylantin for her epilepsy during the pregnancy and had full anesthesia and unprotected X-rays in the first trimester. Thankfully, my daughter's birthmother, though handicapped, was no pushover and when the doctor refused to tell her the cost or the possible complications of a saline abortion, she walked out and went to Birthright. The people at Birthright tried everything they could to convince my daughter's birthmother that adoption through an agency was the best way to go, but she stubbornly stuck to her decision to place her child in the home of her choice. Praise God, that family turned out to be us!

Catie is a beautiful, articulate, nurturing woman about to unveil her first child. I carry around a picture of "Baby Rose" who was found in a dumpster after she had been aborted by saline solution when she was at six months gestation. Next to Baby Rose, I have a perfect picture of my Catie when she was about three. She has on a red and white dress with a full, fluffy petticoat. She's swinging and her smile is accented by her big sparkling eyes. I ask people, which is better? Life? Or burning a child to death with salt in her mother's womb?

Abortion is a scourge on our society. As I teach my beautiful students, I wonder who's missing. I have had constant health problems caused by the abortion. I was rendered barren by Planned Parenthood. I was unable to follow my chosen profession for which I had trained since I was five years old. You see, I was a dancer and scar tissue doesn't stretch- it tears and makes more scar tissue. They took my money, killed my child, and left me scarred, barren, and broken. They talk compassion and choice. It is the big lie. The Planned Parenthood doctor who went from patient to patient using the same dirty equipment had no compassion. The "counselor" at Planned Parenthood gave me no choices.



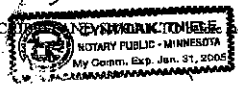

- 4) Were you informed of any link between abortion and breast cancer? NO Have you had breast cancer? NO DECISION.
- 5) Did anyone pressure you into having an abortion? IF NOT, WHO? MY BOYFRIEND, TOM, AT THE TIME I BECAME PREGNANT, WHEN WE DISCUSSED THIS, WE BELIEVED THIS TO BE THE ONLY OPTION AVAILABLE.
- 6) How has your abortion affected you? I SHUT DOWN EMOTIONALLY, REFUSED ANY SERIOUS RELATIONSHIPS BECAUSE I KNEW WHERE IT WOULD LEAD, DID NOT WANT CHILDREN, AND ERECTED A WALL AROUND MYSELF TO PROTECT MYSELF FROM ANY AND ALL KINDS OF INTIMACY. - 7) How has your abortion affected others in your life? THERE WAS A WALL BETWEEN MY HUSBAND & I. THE FIRST 8 YEARS OF MARRIAGE, SEX AND INTIMACY WERE VERY DIFFICULT & UNCOMFORTABLE.
- 8) Based on your own experiences, what would you tell a woman considering an abortion? DON'T EVEN CONSIDER IT! I SUFFERED FEELINGS OF DEPRESSION & SUICIDAL THOUGHTS AND SUFFERED FOR 22 YEARS FROM THE EFFECTS OF MY ABORTION. I HAVE ONLY RECENTLY HAD A BREAKTHROUGH TOTALLY FROM MY PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS CHRIST.
- 9) Based on your own experience, what would you tell a court that believes abortion should be legal? THERE IS A BIGGER PICTURE AT STAKE, A BIGGER PRIZE TO FIGHT FOR THAN WE COULD EVER HAVE IMAGINED. IT IS TIME TO STOP SHEDDING INNOCENT BLOOD AT THE EXPENSE OF OUR SEVERAL. IF IT FEELS GOOD, DO IT! MENTALLY, FEELINGS WILL ERE, CONTRARY TO POPULAR BELIEF, THERE ARE ABSOLUTE TRUTHS. ONE IS "THOU SHALT NOT KILL."

"I am over the age of eighteen years, and I am of sound mind and competent to make this affidavit. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated in this affidavit, and I do solemnly swear, or affirm, that the following facts are true:

- 1) Tell approximately when and where your abortion occurred: July 19, 1975, Dallas abortion clinic
- 2) Were you adequately informed of the nature and consequences of abortion, what it is, what it does? No! Just years later I found out I had actually murdered my own baby. The doctor it took me years to find that out was supposed to be for the complete denial of what it had actually done to me!!!
- 4) Were you informed of any link between abortion and breast cancer? No Have you had breast cancer? No
- 5) Did anyone pressure you into having an abortion? No If so, who? \_\_\_\_\_
- 6) How has your abortion affected you? I tried to commit suicide, I hated myself. I was told by the medical staff my paper did that it was just a seed or some stuff and it was just a blob of blood. Then I was so sad it could go to hell. It was a baby till it was. At least three or four months in there. I was happy. My mother and I went to the clinic in Dallas to get back home. I said I must say my mother was all for it before we left. I called my mother. She knows I know that it would be of no use. I said that I put on me guilt on me just before we left. She told me it was the best thing to do.

I can look back and see how it messed up my life. I think about my baby often. I'm missing what it was. I wish it had done to my baby & others would they want there. I wish my sister or I could just go through this. I wish I could give myself a right sum to be able to go back & stop from ever thinking of doing such a thing much. I have read the above and foregoing statement and the same is true and correct. It was an abortion!!!!
- 9) Based on your own experience, what would you tell a court that believes abortion should be legal? If they knew what it had done to my baby & others would they want there. I wish my sister or I could just go through this. I wish I could give myself a right sum to be able to go back & stop from ever thinking of doing such a thing much.
