AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-1592, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO CIVIL TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-1592, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-1592. Commencement of action

5 A. A civil traffic violation case is commenced by issuance ~~or filing~~
6 of a uniform traffic complaint as provided in this article.

7 B. A civil traffic violation case shall be commenced ~~either~~ AS
8 FOLLOWS:

9 1. Within sixty days of the alleged violation.

10 2. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH 3, within one hundred eighty days
11 of the alleged violation if the alleged violation is under investigation in
12 conjunction with a traffic accident.

13 3. WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THE ALLEGED VIOLATION IF THE ALLEGED VIOLATION
14 IS UNDER INVESTIGATION IN CONJUNCTION WITH A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT RESULTING IN
15 DEATH.
