AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 13-3110, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO EXPLOSIVES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-3110, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 13-3110. Misconduct involving simulated explosive devices:
5 classification; definition

6 A. A person commits misconduct involving simulated explosive devices
7 by intentionally giving or sending to another person or placing in a private
8 or public place a simulated explosive device with the intent to terrify,
9 intimidate, threaten or harass.

10 B. The placing or sending of a simulated explosive device without
11 written notice attached to the device in a conspicuous place that the device
12 has been rendered inert and is possessed for the purpose of curio or relic
13 collection, display or other similar purpose is prima facie evidence of
14 intent to terrify, intimidate, threaten or harass.

15 C. Misconduct involving simulated explosive devices is a class
16 ~~1-misdemeanor~~ 4 FELONY.

17 D. ~~It~~ FOR THE PURPOSES OF this section, "simulated explosive device"
18 means a simulation of a prohibited weapon described in section 13-3101,
19 SUBSECTION A, paragraph 7, subdivision (a) or (f) that a reasonable person
20 would believe is such a prohibited weapon.
