AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 1157

OFFERED BY MRS. MYRICK OF NORTH CAROLINA

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Breast Cancer and3 Environmental Research Act of 2008".

4 SEC. 2. EXPANDING COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH ON 5 BREAST CANCER AND THE ENVIRONMENT.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subpart 1 of part C of title IV
7 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 285 et seq.)
8 is amended by adding at the end the following:

9 "SEC. 417F. INTERAGENCY BREAST CANCER AND ENVIRON-

10MENTAL RESEARCH COORDINATING COM-11MITTEE.

12 "(a) INTERAGENCY BREAST CANCER AND ENVIRON13 MENTAL RESEARCH COORDINATING COMMITTEE.—

14 "(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 6
15 months after the date of the enactment of this sec16 tion, the Secretary shall establish a committee, to be
17 known as the Interagency Breast Cancer and Envi-

1	ronmental Research Coordinating Committee (in this
2	section referred to as the 'Committee').
3	"(2) DUTIES.—The Committee shall—
4	"(A) share and coordinate information on
5	existing research activities, and make rec-
6	ommendations to the National Institutes of
7	Health and other Federal agencies regarding
8	how to improve existing research programs,
9	that are related to breast cancer research;
10	"(B) develop a comprehensive strategy and
11	advise the National Institutes of Health and
12	other Federal agencies in the solicitation of pro-
13	posals for collaborative, multidisciplinary re-
14	search, including proposals to evaluate environ-
15	mental and genomic factors that may be related
16	to the etiology of breast cancer that would—
17	"(i) result in innovative approaches to
18	study emerging scientific opportunities or
19	eliminate knowledge gaps in research to
20	improve the research portfolio;
21	"(ii) outline key research questions,
22	methodologies, and knowledge gaps;
23	"(iii) expand the number of research
24	proposals that involve collaboration be-
25	tween 2 or more national research insti-

1 tutes or national centers, includ	ling pro-
2 posals for Common Fund rese	arch de-
3 scribed in section 402(b)(7) to imp	prove the
4 research portfolio; and	
5 "(iv) expand the number of	collabo-
6 rative, multidisciplinary, and mult	ti-institu-
7 tional research grants;	
8 "(C) develop a summary of adv	vances in
9 breast cancer research supported or c	onducted
10 by Federal agencies relevant to the d	liagnosis,
11 prevention, and treatment of cancer a	und other
12 diseases and disorders; and	
13 "(D) not later than 2 years after	the date
14 of the establishment of the Committ	ee, make
15 recommendations to the Secretary—	
16 "(i) regarding any ap	propriate
17 changes to research activities,	including
18 recommendations to improve the	research
19 portfolio of the National Insti	itutes of
20 Health to ensure that scientifica	ally-based
21 strategic planning is implemented	l in sup-
22 port of research priorities that	t impact
23 breast cancer research activities;	
24 "(ii) to ensure that the act	ivities of
25 the National Institutes of Health a	and other

1	Federal agencies, including the Depart-
2	ment of Defense, are free of unnecessary
3	duplication of effort;
4	"(iii) regarding public participation in
5	decisions relating to breast cancer research
6	to increase the involvement of patient ad-
7	vocacy and community organizations rep-
8	resenting a broad geographical area;
9	"(iv) on how best to disseminate in-
10	formation on breast cancer research
11	progress; and
12	"(v) on how to expand partnerships
13	between public entities, including Federal
14	agencies, and private entities to expand
15	collaborative, cross-cutting research.
16	"(3) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—For the pur-
17	poses of the Committee, when focusing on research
18	to evaluate environmental and genomic factors that
19	may be related to the etiology of breast cancer, noth-
20	ing in this Act shall be construed to restrict the Sec-
21	retary from including other forms of cancer, as ap-
22	propriate, when doing so may advance research in
23	breast cancer or advance research in other forms of
24	cancer.

25 "(4) Membership.—

1	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Committee shall
2	be composed of the following voting members:
3	"(i) Not more than 7 voting Federal
4	representatives as follows:
5	"(I) The Director of the Centers
6	for Disease Control and Prevention.
7	"(II) The Director of the Na-
8	tional Institutes of Health and the di-
9	rectors of such national research insti-
10	tutes and national centers (which may
11	include the National Institute of Envi-
12	ronmental Health Sciences) as the
13	Secretary determines appropriate.
14	"(III) One representative from
15	the National Cancer Institute Board
16	of Scientific Advisors, appointed by
17	the Director of the National Cancer
18	Institute.
19	"(IV) The heads of such other
20	agencies of the Department of Health
21	and Human Services as the Secretary
22	determines appropriate.
23	"(V) Representatives of other
23 24	"(V) Representatives of other Federal agencies that conduct or sup-

1	port cancer research, including the
2	Department of Defense.
3	"(ii) 12 additional voting members ap-
4	pointed under subparagraph (B).
5	"(B) Additional members.—The Com-
6	mittee shall include additional voting members
7	appointed by the Secretary as follows:
8	"(i) 6 members shall be appointed
9	from among scientists, physicians, and
10	other health professionals, who—
11	"(I) are not officers or employees
12	of the United States;
13	"(II) represent multiple dis-
14	ciplines, including clinical, basic, and
15	public health sciences;
16	"(III) represent different geo-
17	graphical regions of the United
18	States;
19	"(IV) are from practice settings,
20	academia, or other research settings;
21	and
22	"(V) are experienced in scientific
23	peer review process.

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1	"(ii) 6 members shall be appointed
2	from members of the general public, who
3	represent individuals with breast cancer.
4	"(C) Nonvoting members.—The Com-
5	mittee shall include such nonvoting members as
6	the Secretary determines to be appropriate.
7	"(5) CHAIRPERSON.—The voting members of
8	the Committee shall select a chairperson from
9	among such members. The selection of a chairperson
10	shall be subject to the approval of the Director of
11	NIH.
12	"(6) MEETINGS.—The Committee shall meet at
13	the call of the chairperson of the Committee or upon
14	the request of the Director of NIH, but in no case
15	less often than once each year.
16	"(b) REVIEW.—The Secretary shall review the neces-
17	sity of the Committee in calendar year 2011 and, there-
18	after, at least once every 2 years.".
19	(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—For the
20	purpose of carrying out research activities under title IV
21	of the Public Health Service Act, including section 417F
22	of such Act, as added by subsection (a) there are author-
23	ized to be appropriated \$40,000,000 for each of fiscal
24	years 2009 through 2012. Amounts authorized to be ap-
25	propriated under the preceding sentence shall be in addi-

- 1 tion to amounts otherwise authorized to be appropriated
- 2~ for such purpose under section 402A of the Public Health
- 3 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 282a).
