- **News: Drinking Water Quality Standards**

Ministry of Health of the People's Republic of China and Standardization Administration jointly updated the Drinking Water Quality Standards (GB5749-2006) on December 29 2006, which will come into effect on July 1 2007, replacing the previous standard (GB5749-85).

The main changes are as follows:

1. Water quality parameters are increased from 35 items to 106 items; 71 new items and 8 revised items;
2. Two sections; water source selection and protection of water sources, are deleted;
3. Simplify the monitoring requirements of the water supply department.

Detailed information is as follows:

1. Definition for water supply; centralized water supply, secondary water supply, small-scale centralized water supply for rural areas, non-centralized water supply, regular parameters and non-regular parameters;
2. Requirements for portable water, portable water source, centralized water supplier secondary water supply, water quality standards;
3. Water quality monitoring for different water suppliers.
