AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-901.04; RELATING TO SCHOOL FINANCE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 9, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 15-901.04, to read:

4 15-901.04. School district noncompliance; withholding of monies

5 IF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, THE AUDITOR GENERAL OR THE ATTORNEY
6 GENERAL DETERMINES THAT A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS SUBSTANTIALLY AND DELIBERATELY
7 NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS TITLE AND IF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS FAILED TO
8 CORRECT THE DEFICIENCY WITHIN NINETY DAYS AFTER RECEIVING NOTICE FROM THE
9 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY DIRECT THE
10 SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, PURSUANT TO RULES ADOPTED BY THE STATE
11 BOARD OF EDUCATION, TO WITHHOLD THE MONIES THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WOULD
12 OTHERWISE BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FROM THE DATE OF THE DETERMINATION OF
13 NONCOMPLIANCE UNTIL THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DETERMINES THAT THE SCHOOL
14 DISTRICT IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THIS TITLE.
