AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE NAVAJO  
CODE TALKERS MONUMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: Navajo code talkers monument:  
3 exemption

4 A. Notwithstanding the limitations on donations in section 41-1363,  
5 subsection C, Arizona Revised Statutes, the sum of \$100,000 is appropriated  
6 from the state general fund in fiscal year 2007-2008 to the department of  
7 administration for the Navajo code talkers monument.

8 B. Before expenditure of any of the monies appropriated pursuant to  
9 subsection A of this section, the Navajo Tribe shall donate a matching  
10 \$100,000 for the monument.

11 C. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
12 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
13 lapsing of appropriations.
