activated features of other products that are identified as accessibility features, where those features are developed and documented according to industry standards.				
Applications also shall not disrupt or disable activated features of any operating system that are identified as accessibility features where the application programming interface for those accessibility features has been documented by the manufacturer of the operating system and is available to the product developer.				
(c) A well-defined onscreen indication of the current focus shall be provided that moves among interactive interface elements as the input focus changes.				
The focus shall be programmatically exposed so that assistive technology can track focus and focus changes.				
(d) Sufficient information about a user interface element including the identity, operation and state of the element shall be available to assistive technology.				
When an image represents a program element, the information conveyed by the image must also be available in text.				
(e) When bitmap images are used to identify controls, status indicators, or other programmatic elements, the meaning assigned to those images shall be consistent throughout an application's performance.				
(f) Textual information shall be provided through operating system functions for displaying text. The minimum information that shall be made available is text content, text input caret location, and text attributes.

(k) Software shall not use flashing or blinking text,

site comply with the provisions of this part, when				
compliance cannot be accomplished in any other				
way.				
The content of the text-only page shall be updated				
whenever the primary page changes.				
(1) When pages utilize scripting languages to				
display content, or to create interface elements, the				
information provided by the script shall be				
identified with functional text that can be read by				
assistive technology.				
(m) When a web page requires that an applet,				
plug-in or other application be present on the				
client system to interpret page content, the page				
must provide a link to a plug-in or applet that				
complies with § 1194.21(a) through (l).
