COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SUSPENSION OF OVER-THE-COUNTER TRADING OF THE SECURITIES OF HEALTHTECH INTERNATIONAL, INC.

The Commission announced the temporary suspension of over-thecounter trading of the securities of HealthTech International, Inc. The trading suspension began at 9:30 a.m. on November 17, 1997, and terminates at 11:59 p.m. on December 1, 1997. HealthTech is based in Mesa, Arizona and operates health clubs in Texas, Oregon and Arizona.

The Commission temporarily suspended trading in the securities of HealthTech because of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information about HealthTech concerning, among other things, its financial condition and acquisitions made by the company.

The Commission cautions broker-dealers, shareholders and prospective purchasers that they should carefully consider the foregoing information along with all other currently available information and any information subsequently issued by HealthTech. (Rel. 34-39330)

FEE RATE ADVISORY - NOVEMBER 17 UPDATE

The current continuing resolution has been extended through November 26. As a result of this extension, the fee rate for Section 6(b)filings will remain at the current rate of 1/33rd of one percent of the aggregate offering amount. This fee is calculated by dividing the aggregate offering amount by 3300.

This rate will be in effect until the pending appropriations bill is enacted or another continuing resolution is enacted. When the appropriations bill (which has been passed by the Congress but not yet signed by the President) is enacted, the fee rate will be decreased to \$295 per \$1,000,000 (pro rated for amounts less than This fee will be calculated by multiplying the \$1,000,000). aggregate offering amount by .000295.

The Commission will issue further notices as appropriate to keep filers and registrants informed of developments affecting the Section 6(b) fee rate. This information will be posted at the SEC's

The Commission issued a release soliciting public comment on proposed Rule 154 under the Securities Act of 1933 and amendments to Rules 30d-1 and 30d-2 under the Investment Company Act and Rules 14a-3, 14c-3 and 14c-7 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposals would permit delivery of a single prospectus or shareholder report to investors sharing the same address. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

JOHN LOGAN CONSENTS TO THE ENTRY OF AN INJUNCTION AND AGREES TO PAY A \$10,000 CIVIL PENALTY IN CONNECTION WITH BAUSCH & LOMB, INCORPORATED'S MATERIAL OVERSTATEMENT OF 1993 REVENUE BY \$42.1 MILLION.

The Commission today announced the filing of a civil injunctive action against John Logan, a former Regional Sales Director of B&L's Contact Lens Division (CLD). The complaint alleges that Logan aided and abetted B&L's violation of the antifraud, reporting, recordkeeping, and internal controls provisions of the federal securities laws, and directly violated the internal controls provisions, by granting, and instructing others to grant, certain B&L distributors the right to return contact lenses in connection with a year-end 1993 marketing program. The complaint alleges that B&L materially overstated revenue by \$42.1 million, \$22 million of which came through consignment sales in the CLD, and \$17.6 million in net income for its fiscal year 1993.

Without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, Logan consented to a proposed Final Judgment enjoining him from violating, or aiding and abetting violations of, the antifraud, reporting, recordkeeping, and internal controls provisions of the federal securities laws. BAUSCH & LOMB, INCORPORATED (B&L), HAROLD JOHNSON, ERMIN IANACONE, AND KURT MATSUMOTO CONSENT TO THE ENTRY OF CEASE-AND-DESIST ORDERS IN CONNECTION WITH B&L'S MATERIAL OVERSTATEMENT OF 1993 REVENUE BY \$42.1 MILLION

The Commission today announced that it instituted and settled administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 21C of the Exchange Act against Respondents B&L, a manufacturer of contact lenses and sunglasses, Harold Johnson, the former President of B&L's Contact Lens Division (CLD) and Senior Vice President of B&L, Ermin Ianacone, the CLD's former Controller and Vice President of Finance, and Kurt Matsumoto, the CLD's former Director of Distributor Sales. The Commission found that B&L materially overstated revenue by \$42.1 million and net income by at least \$17.6 million for its 1993 fiscal year through consignment sales in the CLD and the fraudulent sale of sunglasses in its Asia-Pacific Division. The Commission found that Ianacone and Matsumoto caused B&L's violations of the antifraud, reporting, recordkeeping, and internal controls provisions of the federal securities laws and directly violated the internal controls provisions. Johnson caused B&L's violation of the reporting provisions.

Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, each Respondent consented to the entry of a cease-and-desist order. (Rel. 34-39329; AAE Rel. 987; File No. 3-9488)

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST VINCENT SETTEDUCATE

On November 14, the Commission filed a civil action in federal court in Manhattan against Vincent Setteducate, a/k/a Vincent Sette (Setteducate). According to the Commission's complaint, from early 1992 through 1994, Setteducate defrauded six investors of \$200,000 in a fraudulent "prime bank" securities scheme.

The Commission alleges that Setteducate made materially false and misleading statements to investors with the intent to misappropriate their money for his personal and business expenses, and that he did in fact misappropriate investor funds.

In its complaint, the Commission alleges that Setteducate violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Commission seeks a permanent injunction against future violations of the antifraud provisions, disgorgement of Setteducate's ill-gotten gains plus prejudgment interest, and civil penalties. The litigation is pending. [SEC v. Vincent Setteducate, 97 Civ. 8472, SAS, SDNY] (LR-15561)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SMITH BARNEY MUNI FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Smith Barney Muni Funds (Trust), et al. under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting relief from Section 17(a). The order permits a series of the Trust to acquire substantially all of the assets and certain liabilities of another series of the Trust. (Rel. IC-22886 - November 13)

GOLDMAN SACHS & CO., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Goldman Sachs & Co., et al. under: Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act; Section 6(c) for an exemption from Section 17(e) of the Act and Rule 17e-1 under the Act; and Section 10(f) of the Act for an exemption from Section 10(f) and Rule 10f-3 under the Act. The order permits registered investment companies that have one or more investment advisers, and for which Goldman, Sachs & Co. or an affiliate (Goldman) acts as an investment adviser, to engage in certain principal and brokerage transactions and to purchase securities in certain underwritings. The transactions would be between the investment companies, or the portions of the investment companies' portfolios, that are not advised by Goldman, and Goldman or a member of an underwriting syndicate in which Goldman is a participant.
