### **NERC Annual Report Forecasts Reliable Winter Energy November 14**

North American energy capacity should comfortably meet winter demand, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation said yesterday in its annual *Winter Reliability Assessment*. The report cited improved demand response, new transmission capacity, and record fuel supply, and said every North American Region forecasts that its energy capacity is in excess of target points. Southeast United States droughts will not affect viability, the group said. ### Southern Cancels 285 MW IGCC Project in Florida, to Build Gas-Fired Plant Instead

Southern Co. and the Orlando Utilities Commission abandoned plans to construct a 285 MW integrated gasification combined cycle plant, despite starting construction on the facility two months ago, sources reported. Instead, the companies will build a natural gas-fired facility at the same site—the Stanton Energy Center near Orlando, Florida. Spokesmen blamed in-flux state environmental regulations, saying it was unclear if the clean-coal facility would be able to meet future restrictions. ### OPEC to Export More Oil than Expected, up 380,000 b/d, Analyst Says November 15

OPEC, minus Angola, will export 380,000 b/d more in the four weeks ending December 1 than it did in the period ending November 3, Oil Movements said today. The forecast comes despite predictions that reduced output from the United Arab Emirates, undergoing maintenance, would negate proposed OPEC hikes.

## Crude Pipeline in Nigeria Attacked—50,000 b/d Might be Shut-in November 15

Attackers with dynamite ruptured an oil pipeline to Shell's 400,000 b/d Forcados export terminal, according to multiple news outlets. An industry source said between 20,000 and 50,000 b/d are shut-in, though Shell did not confirm any impact. Similar assaults have reduced Nigeria's crude output by 20 percent over the past two years, according to the Associated Press. The revel movement MEND claimed responsibility for the attack.
