Revision made from photo print of the original topographic sheet, from which tracings were made.

These tracings, with reductions of plans of streets etc, were carried into the field, and the changes noted and new features plotted in position by angles and measures taken from identified objects identified on the original sheets.

Roads and groups of streets and houses, conventionalized. But are plotted with such accuracy as it will require an instrumental investigation to develop discrepancies.

Main roads, roads leading to or from the station electric and steam roads are noted.

Power lines, detached houses remote from station and by roads are shown only when they could be noted while other information was being secured.
