AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 34, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTIONS 36-3416, 36-3417 AND 36-3418; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; RELATING TO THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 34, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding sections 36-3416, 36-3417 and 36-3418, to read:

4 36-3416. Crisis intervention team training program:
5 coordinator; duties; report; program termination

6 A. THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES SHALL ESTABLISH
7 IN THE DIVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH THE POSITION OF CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM
8 TRAINING PROGRAM COORDINATOR.

9 B. THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR SHALL APPOINT THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM
10 TRAINING PROGRAM COORDINATOR TO WORK WITH ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THIS
11 STATE THAT REQUESTS ASSISTANCE TO COORDINATE THE PROVISION OF CRISIS
12 INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING TO ITS FIRST RESPONDERS AS PART OF A SPECIALIZED
13 RESPONSE TEAM OR AS PART OF THE TRAINING FOR FIRST RESPONDERS. THE CRISIS
14 INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM COORDINATOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE
15 DEPUTY DIRECTOR. THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM COORDINATOR
16 SHALL:

17 1. WORK WITH COMMUNITIES TO DEVELOP PARTNERSHIPS, COORDINATE
18 ACTIVITIES AND PROMOTE COOPERATION AND COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT
19 OF HEALTH SERVICES, DIVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES,
20 DISABILITY SERVICE PROVIDERS AND PEOPLE WITH PSYCHIATRIC OR OTHER
21 DISABILITIES AND THEIR FAMILIES TO PROVIDE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING.

22 2. PROVIDE COORDINATION ACTIVITIES AND FUNDING SUPPORT FOR CRISIS
23 INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING. ALL TRAINING SHALL BE BASED ON THE MEMPHIS
24 CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PROFESSIONALS WHO
25 ARE FIRST RESPONDERS TO SITUATIONS INVOLVING PEOPLE EXPERIENCING A
26 PSYCHIATRIC CRISIS OR SYMPTOMS OF A DISABILITY THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE
27 TRAINING CURRICULA APPROVED BY THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM
28 ADVISORY COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 36-3417 AND THE ARIZONA PEACE
29 OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD.

30 3. PROVIDE SUPPORT, TRAINING AND COMMUNITY COORDINATION TO ENSURE THAT
31 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICE PROVIDERS IN THE COMMUNITY PROVIDE ALTERNATIVES TO
32 INCARCERATION BASED ON THE MEMPHIS CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM.

33 4. THROUGH FEDERAL AND PRIVATE GRANTS, GIFTS OR CONTRIBUTIONS, PROVIDE
34 FUNDING TO SUPPORT TRAINING AND COMMUNITY COORDINATION COSTS AS NECESSARY.
35 ALL MONIES SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING FUND
36 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 36-3418.

37 5. IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY SECTION
38 36-3417, DISTRIBUTE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING FUND MONIES AS NEEDED
39 FOR SUPPORT, TRAINING AND COMMUNITY COORDINATION COSTS.

40 6. SUBMIT A REPORT ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR TO THE DEPUTY
41 DIRECTOR AND THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING ADVISORY COMMITTEE THAT
42 CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING:

43 (a) A REVIEW OF ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES THAT HAVE PROVIDED CRISIS
44 INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING TO THEIR OFFICERS AND THE NUMBER OF OFFICERS THAT
45 HAVE COMPLETED THE TRAINING.

1 (b) A LIST OF COMMUNITIES IN THIS STATE THAT HAVE IMPLEMENTED THE
2 MEMPHIS CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM THROUGH TRAINING AND
3 COORDINATION, INCLUDING THE LENGTH OF IMPLEMENTATION AND CURRENT STATUS OF
4 THE PROGRAM.

5 (c) RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT IN THE COMMUNITY BASED
6 PARTNERSHIPS THAT SUPPORT CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM RESPONSES.

7 (d) RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PUBLIC
8 SAFETY AGENCIES THAT PROVIDE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM RESPONSES.

9 (e) A REVIEW OF ALL FUNDING RESOURCES THAT THE CRISIS INTERVENTION
10 TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM COORDINATOR HAS APPLIED FOR TO INCREASE AVAILABLE
11 FUNDING, INCLUDING THE STATUS OF ALL FUNDING REQUESTS AND THE TOTAL OF MONIES
12 RECEIVED YEAR TO DATE.

13 C. THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM COORDINATOR SHALL
14 PROVIDE A COPY OF THE REPORT PRESCRIBED BY SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION TO
15 THE GOVERNOR, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE PRESIDENT OF
16 THE SENATE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE ARIZONA STATE
17 LIBRARY, ARCHIVES AND PUBLIC RECORDS.

18 D. THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION ENDS ON JULY 1, 2017
19 PURSUANT TO SECTION 41-3102.

20 36-3417. Crisis intervention team training program advisory
21 committee; member; duties

22 A. THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM ADVISORY COMMITTEE IS
23 ESTABLISHED CONSISTING OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

24 1. THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR, WHO SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRPERSON OF THE
25 COMMITTEE AND WHO IS A NONVOTING MEMBER.

26 2. THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM COORDINATOR, WHO IS A
27 NONVOTING MEMBER.

28 3. ONE MEMBER WHO IS RECOMMENDED BY THE ARIZONA PEACE OFFICER
29 STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE
30 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

31 4. ONE MEMBER WHO IS A CERTIFIED PEACE OFFICER AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY
32 THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

33 5. ONE MEMBER WHO IS A DETENTION EMPLOYEE OF A SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT
34 AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

35 6. ONE MEMBER WHO IS A CONSUMER OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES AND WHO
36 IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

37 7. ONE MEMBER WHO IS AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER OF A CONSUMER OF
38 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE
39 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

40 8. ONE MEMBER WHO IS A PERSON WITH A DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AND WHO
41 IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

42 9. ONE MEMBER WHO IS EITHER A FAMILY MEMBER OR GUARDIAN OF A PERSON
43 WITH A DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE
44 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

1 10. ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A STATEWIDE ADVOCACY AGENCY THAT SERVES
2 PERSONS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES AND THEIR FAMILIES AND WHO IS
3 APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

4 11. ONE MEMBER WHO IS A PSYCHIATRIST OR PSYCHOLOGIST LICENSED PURSUANT
5 TO TITLE 32 AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
6 SERVICES.

7 12. ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A STATEWIDE BEHAVIOR HEALTH ADVOCACY
8 GROUP, AGENCY OR ASSOCIATION AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE
9 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

10 13. ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AUTHORITY AND WHO IS
11 APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

12 B. THE COMMITTEE SHALL:

13 1. MEET AT LEAST TWICE EACH YEAR AND AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIRPERSON.

14 2. REVIEW THE REPORT REQUIRED BY SECTION 36-3416 AND, BASED ON THAT
15 REPORT, MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE DIVISION, THE DEPARTMENT, THE GOVERNOR,
16 THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

17 3. APPROVE TRAINING CURRICULA THAT MEET OR EXCEED STANDARDS PRESCRIBED
18 BY THE ARIZONA PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD.

19 C. COMMITTEE MEMBERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR COMPENSATION BUT ARE
20 ELIGIBLE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES PURSUANT TO TITLE 38, CHAPTER 4,
21 ARTICLE 2.

22 36-3418. Crisis intervention team training fund; reports

23 A. THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING FUND IS ESTABLISHED TO
24 PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT WHEN NECESSARY AND AS AVAILABLE FOR TRAINING AND
25 COMMUNITY COORDINATION COSTS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MEMPHIS CRISIS
26 INTERVENTION TEAM TRAINING PROGRAM TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AS REQUESTED.
27 THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

28 B. THE DIRECTOR MAY ACCEPT AND SPEND FEDERAL MONIES AND PRIVATE
29 GRANTS, GIFTS, CONTRIBUTIONS AND DEVISES TO ASSIST IN CARRYING OUT THE
30 PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.

31 C. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED AND ARE EXEMPT
32 FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35-190 RELATING TO LAPSING OF APPROPRIATIONS.
33 ON NOTICE FROM THE DIRECTOR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST AND DIVEST
34 MONIES IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 35-313, AND MONIES EARNED FROM
35 INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

36 D. THE CONTRACTORS THAT RECEIVE MONIES PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL
37 SUBMIT QUARTERLY REPORTS TO THE DIRECTOR REGARDING THE USE AND EFFECTIVENESS
38 OF THE DISTRIBUTED MONIES. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ANNUALLY SUBMIT A SUMMARY OF
39 THE REPORTS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND A PROGRESS REPORT ON THE
40 STATE AND LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS' EFFORTS TO THE GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT OF
41 THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE JOINT
42 LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE. THE DIRECTOR SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE
43 REPORTS TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE ARIZONA STATE
44 LIBRARY, ARCHIVES AND PUBLIC RECORDS.
