Weather Synopsis:


A broad ridge of high pressure remains across the state providing hot and dry conditions with minimum humidities in single digits and teens. Poor overnight humidity recovery. The first push of monsoonal moisture will move into southern NV this afternoon with a good chance of dry thunderstorms.

Westerly afternoon winds 6 to 12 mph in the western zones, upslope / upvalley winds less than 10 mph in the central, northeast and southwest winds up to 10 mph in the southern zones.

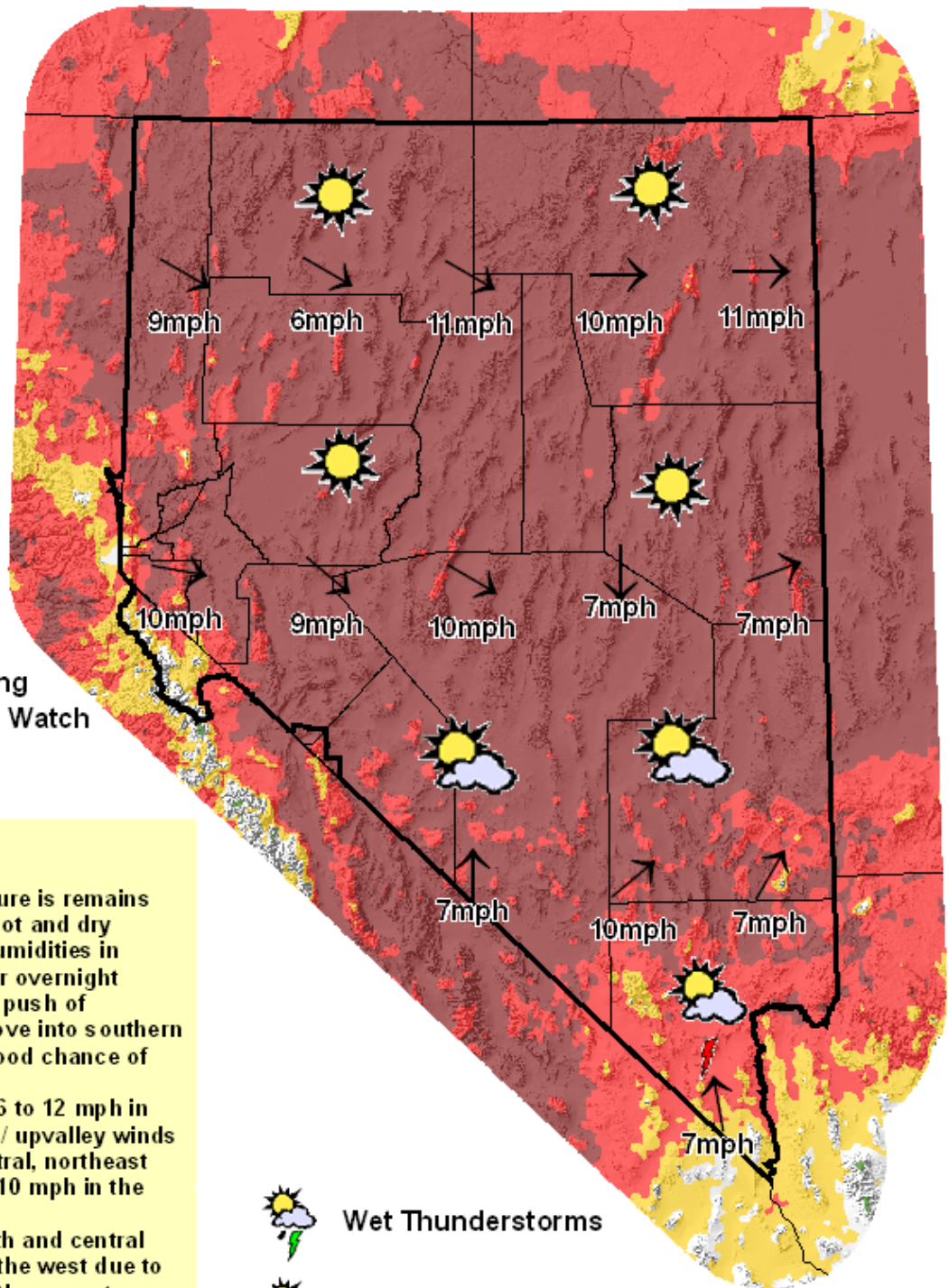
Sunny skies across the north and central portions with some haze in the west due to smoke from California. Mostly sunny to partly cloudy in the southern zones.

Thursday's high temperatures will be between 91 and 109 in the north and central portions, between 82 and 98 in the southern mountains and 98 to 108 in the southern deserts.
