AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY FOR THE
INDEPENDENT LIVING PROGRAM FOR THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; independent living program; exemption

3 A. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law, the sum of
4 \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year
5 2007-2008 to the department of economic security for the independent living
6 program for the visually impaired.

7 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
8 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
9 lapsing of appropriations.
