

CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE COST ESTIMATE

S. 1267 District of Columbia Budget Autonomy Act of 2003

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Governmental Affairs on October 22, 2003

- S. 1267 would allow the District of Columbia to enact the portion of its annual budget that is locally funded. Under current law, the District of Columbia cannot spend any local or federal funds until its annual appropriation from the federal government has been enacted. CBO estimates that enacting S. 1267 would have no impact on the federal budget.
- S. 1267 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on the District of Columbia.
