AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 8-525; RELATING TO CHILD WELFARE AND PLACEMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 8, chapter 5, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding section 8-525, to read:

4 8-525. Children in foster care; department intent

5 IT IS THE INTENT OF THE DEPARTMENT THAT EACH CHILD IN FOSTER CARE IS
6 PLACED IN A HOME THAT ENCOURAGES THE CHILD'S SENSE OF SECURITY AND DIGNITY
7 AND THAT PROMOTES THE CHILD'S HEALTHY DEVELOPMENT TOWARD ADULTHOOD.
