SUBJECT: Processing Requests for Section 515 Rural Rental Housing (RRH) Loans (Designated Places List attached)

TO: Multi-Family Housing Staff USDA, Rural Development Oregon

## PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME:

The purpose of this Administrative Notice (AN) is to provide interested parties with the list of communities in Oregon which are eligible for Section 515 Multi-Family Housing new construction funding.

## **COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN:**

This replaces Oregon AN NO. 1274 (1944-E) dated December 22, 2004 and the Designated Place List for FY2005.

## **IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Use this information to answer loan inquiries and provide a copy of this Administrative Notice to parties interested in obtaining a Rural Development (RD) Section 515 Multi-Family Housing loan.

All eligible rural places in Oregon have been ranked in accordance with these revisions using 2000 Census data on median household income and numbers of substandard housing units to select the communities with the highest need.

Information regarding proposed assisted housing is obtained from other housing finance agencies. Communities which have proposed apartment complexes with approved funding in place are temporarily removed from the Rural Development list of eligible communities for the current fiscal year. The communities listed on this Administrative Notice are the only ones eligible for RD Section 515 Multi-Family Housing funding during Fiscal year 2006.

Applications, which are received for places not on the list, will be returned to the applicant.
