## AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 38-711, 38-740 AND 38-765, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona: 2 Section 1. Section 38-711, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 3 read: 4 38-711. Definitions 5 In this article, unless the context otherwise requires: "Active member" means a member as defined in paragraph 23, 6 1. 7 subdivision (b) of this section who satisfies the eligibility criteria 8 prescribed in section 38-727 and who is currently making member contributions 9 as prescribed in section 38-736. 2. "Actuarial equivalent" means equality in value of the aggregate 10 11 amounts expected to be received under two different forms of payment, based 12 on mortality and interest rate assumptions approved from time to time by the 13 board. 14 3. "ASRS" means the Arizona state retirement system established by 15 this article. 16 4. "Assets" means the resources of ASRS including all cash, 17 investments or securities. 18 "Average monthly compensation" means: 5. 19 (a) For a member whose membership in ASRS commenced before January 1, 20 1984 and who left the member's contributions on deposit or reinstated 21 forfeited credited service pursuant to section 38-742 for a period of 22 employment that commenced before January 1, 1984, AT THE MEMBER'S ELECTION 23 EITHER: 24 (i) THE MONTHLY AVERAGE OF COMPENSATION THAT IS CALCULATED PURSUANT TO 25 SUBDIVISION (b) OF THIS PARAGRAPH. (ii) The monthly average of compensation on which contributions were 26 27 remitted during a period of sixty consecutive months during which the member 28 receives the highest compensation within the last one hundred twenty months 29 of credited service. Any month for which no contributions are reported to 30 ASRS or that falls within a period of nonpaid or partially paid leave of 31 absence or sabbatical leave shall be excluded from the computation. The 32 sixty consecutive months may entirely precede, may be both before and after 33 or may be completely after any excluded months. If the member was employed 34 for less than sixty consecutive months, the average monthly compensation is 35 based on the total consecutive months worked. Payments for accumulated 36 vacation or annual leave, sick leave, compensatory time or other forms of 37 termination pay which, <del>prior to the effective date of the amendment to this</del> 38 section BEFORE AUGUST 12, 2005, constitute compensation for members whose 39 membership in ASRS commenced before January 1, 1984, do not cease to be 40 included as compensation if paid in the form of nonelective employer 41 contributions under a 26 United States Code section 403(b) plan so long as IF 42 all payments of employer and employee contributions are made at the time of 43 termination. Contributions shall be made to ASRS on these amounts pursuant 44 to sections 38-735, 38-736 and 38-737.

1 (b) Effective July 1, 1985 FOR A MEMBER WHOSE MEMBERSHIP IN ASRS 2 COMMENCED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1984 BUT BEFORE JULY 1, 2009, the monthly 3 average of compensation on which contributions were remitted during a period 4 of thirty-six consecutive months during which a member receives the highest 5 compensation within the last one hundred twenty months of credited service. 6 Any month for which no contributions are reported to ASRS or that falls 7 within a period of nonpaid or partially paid leave of absence or sabbatical 8 leave shall be excluded from the computation. The thirty-six consecutive 9 months may entirely precede, may be both before and after or may be completely after any excluded months. If the member was employed for less 10 11 than thirty-six consecutive months, the average monthly compensation shall be 12 based on the total consecutive months worked. <del>This subdivision applies only</del> 13 to members whose membership in ASRS was effective after December 31, 1983 or 14 who agree in writing as a binding condition of eligibility for being granted 15 the benefit advantages available under this subdivision to have their benefit 16 computed on the basis of the definition of compensation.

17 (c) FOR A MEMBER WHOSE MEMBERSHIP IN ASRS COMMENCED ON OR AFTER JULY 18 1. 2009, THE MONTHLY AVERAGE OF COMPENSATION ON WHICH CONTRIBUTIONS WERE 19 REMITTED DURING A PERIOD OF SIXTY CONSECUTIVE MONTHS DURING WHICH A MEMBER 20 RECEIVES THE HIGHEST COMPENSATION WITHIN THE LAST ONE HUNDRED TWENTY MONTHS 21 OF CREDITED SERVICE. ANY MONTH FOR WHICH NO CONTRIBUTIONS ARE REPORTED TO 22 ASRS OR THAT FALLS WITHIN A PERIOD OF NONPAID OR PARTIALLY PAID LEAVE OF 23 ABSENCE OR SABBATICAL LEAVE SHALL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE COMPUTATION. THE 24 SIXTY CONSECUTIVE MONTHS MAY ENTIRELY PRECEDE, MAY BE BOTH BEFORE AND AFTER 25 OR MAY BE COMPLETELY AFTER ANY EXCLUDED MONTHS. IF THE MEMBER WAS EMPLOYED 26 FOR LESS THAN SIXTY CONSECUTIVE MONTHS, THE AVERAGE MONTHLY COMPENSATION 27 SHALL BE BASED ON THE TOTAL CONSECUTIVE MONTHS WORKED.

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6. "Board" means the ASRS board established in section 38-713.

29 "Compensation" means the gross amount paid to a member by an 7. 30 employer as salary or wages, including amounts that are subject to deferred 31 compensation or tax shelter agreements, for services rendered to or for an 32 employer, or that would have been paid to the member except for the member's 33 election or a legal requirement that all or part of the gross amount be used 34 for other purposes, but does not include amounts paid in excess of 35 compensation limits established in section 38-746. Compensation includes 36 amounts paid as salary or wages to a member by a second employer. 37 Compensation, as provided in paragraph 5, subdivision (b) of this section, 38 does not include:

39 (a) Lump sum payments, on termination of employment, for accumulated 40 vacation or annual leave, sick leave, compensatory time or any other form of 41 termination pay whether the payments are made in one payment or by 42 installments over a period of time.

(b) Damages, costs, attorney fees, interest or other penalties paid
 pursuant to a court order or a compromise settlement or agreement to satisfy
 a grievance or claim even though the amount of the payment is based in whole

or in part on previous salary or wage levels, except that, if the court order compromise settlement or agreement directs salary or wages to be paid for a specific period of time, the payment is compensation for that specific period of time. If the amount directed to be paid is less than the actual salary or wages that would have been paid for the period if service had been performed, the contributions for the period shall be based on the amount of compensation that would have been paid if the service had been performed.

8 (c) Payment, at the member's option, in lieu of fringe benefits that 9 are normally paid for or provided by the employer.

(d) Merit awards pursuant to section 38-613 and performance bonuses
 paid to assistant attorneys general pursuant to section 41-192.

12 8. "Contingent annuitant" means the person named by a member to 13 receive retirement income payable following a member's death after retirement 14 as provided in section 38-760.

9. "Credited service" means, subject to section 38-739, the number of years standing to the member's credit on the books of ASRS during which the member made the required contributions.

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10. "Current annual compensation" means the greater of:

19 (a) Annualized compensation of the full pay period immediately before 20 the date of a request to ASRS to purchase credited service pursuant to 21 section 38-743 or 38-745.

(b) Annualized compensation of the partial year if the member has less
than twelve months total credited service on the date of a request to
purchase credited service pursuant to section 38-743 or 38-745.

25 (c) The sum of the twelve months of compensation immediately before 26 the date of a request to ASRS to purchase credited service pursuant to 27 section 38-743 or 38-745.

(d) The sum of the thirty-six months of compensation immediately
before the date of a request to ASRS to purchase credited service pursuant to
section 38-743 or 38-745 divided by three.

(e) If the member has retired one or more times from ASRS, the average
 monthly compensation that was used for calculating the member's last pension
 benefit times twelve.

34 11. "Early retirement" means retirement before a member's normal 35 retirement date after five years of total credited service and attainment of 36 age fifty.

37 12. "Effective date" means July 1, 1970, except with respect to 38 employers and members whose contributions to ASRS commence thereafter, the 39 effective date of their membership in ASRS is as specified in the applicable 40 joinder agreement.

- 41 13. "Employer" means:
- 42 (a) This state.
  - (b) Participating political subdivisions.

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(c) Participating political subdivision entities.

1 14. "Employer contributions" means all amounts paid into ASRS by an 2 employer on behalf of a member. 3 "Fiscal year" means the period from July 1 of any year to June 30 15. 4 of the following year. 5 16. "Inactive member" means a member who previously made contributions 6 to ASRS and who satisfies each of the following: 7 (a) Has not retired. 8 (b) Is not eligible for active membership in ASRS. 9 (c) Is not currently making contributions to ASRS. (d) Has not withdrawn contributions from ASRS. 10 11 17. "Interest" means the assumed actuarial investment earnings rate 12 approved by the board. 13 "Internal revenue code" means the United States internal revenue 18. 14 code of 1986, as amended. 15 19. "Investment management" means the persons, companies, banks, 16 insurance company investment funds, mutual fund companies, management or any 17 combinations of those entities that are appointed by ASRS and that have 18 responsibility and authority for investment of the monies of ASRS. 19 20. "Late retirement" means retirement after normal retirement. 20 "Leave of absence" means any unpaid leave authorized by the 21. 21 employer, including leaves authorized for sickness or disability or to pursue 22 education or training. 23 22. "Life annuity" means equal monthly installments payable during the 24 member's lifetime after retirement. 25 23. "Member": (a) Means any employee of an employer on the effective date. 26 27 (b) Means all employees of an employer who are eligible for membership 28 pursuant to section 38-727 and who are engaged to work at least twenty weeks 29 in each fiscal year and at least twenty hours each week. 30 (c) Means any person receiving a benefit under ASRS. 31 (d) Means any person who is a former active member of ASRS and who has 32 not withdrawn contributions from ASRS pursuant to section 38-740. 33 (e) Does not include any employee of an employer who is otherwise 34 eligible pursuant to this article and who begins service in a limited 35 appointment for not more than eighteen months on or after July 1, 1979. If 36 the employment exceeds eighteen months, the employee shall be covered by ASRS 37 as of the beginning of the nineteenth month of employment. In order to be 38 excluded under this subdivision, classifications of employees designated by 39 employers as limited appointments must be approved by the director. 40 (f) Does not include any leased employee. For the purposes of section 41 414(n) of the internal revenue code, "leased employee" means an individual 42 who: 43 (i) Is not otherwise an employee of an employer.

1 (ii) Pursuant to a leasing agreement between the employer and another 2 person, performs services for the employer on a substantially full-time basis 3 for at least one year. 4 (iii) Performs services under the primary direction or control of the 5 employer. "Member contributions" means all amounts paid to ASRS by a member. 6 24. 7 25. "Normal costs" means the sum of the individual normal costs for all 8 active members for each fiscal year. The normal cost for an individual 9 active member is the cost that is assigned to the fiscal year using the projected unit credit method. 10 11 26. "Normal retirement age" means the age at which a member reaches the 12 member's normal retirement date. 13 27. "Normal retirement date" means the earliest of the following: 14 (a) A member's sixty-fifth birthday. 15 (b) A member's sixty-second birthday and completion of at least ten 16 years of credited service. 17 (c) FOR A MEMBER WHOSE MEMBERSHIP COMMENCED BEFORE JULY 1, 2009, the 18 first day that the sum of a member's age and years of total credited service 19 equals eighty. FOR A MEMBER WHOSE MEMBERSHIP COMMENCED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 20 2009, THE FIRST DAY THAT THE SUM OF A MEMBER'S AGE AND YEARS OF TOTAL 21 CREDITED SERVICE EQUALS EIGHTY-FIVE. "Political subdivision" means any political subdivision of this 22 28. 23 state and includes a political subdivision entity. 24 29. "Political subdivision entity" means an entity: 25 (a) That is located in this state. (b) That is created in whole or in part by political subdivisions, 26 27 including instrumentalities of political subdivisions. 28 (c) Where a majority of the membership of the entity is composed of 29 political subdivisions. 30 (d) Whose primary purpose is the performance of a government related 31 service. 30. 32 "Retired member" means a member who is receiving retirement 33 benefits pursuant to this article. 34 "Service year" means fiscal year, except that: 31. 35 (a) If the normal work year required of a member is less than the full 36 fiscal year but is for a period of at least nine months, the service year is 37 the normal work year. 38 (b) For a salaried member employed on a contract basis under one 39 contract, or two or more consecutive contracts, for a total period of at 40 least nine months, the service year is the total period of the contract or 41 consecutive contracts. 42 (c) In determining average monthly compensation pursuant to paragraph 43 5 of this section, the service year is considered to be twelve months of 44 compensation.

"State" means this state, including any department, office, board, 2 commission, agency, institution or other instrumentality of this state. 3 "Vested" means that a member is eligible to receive a future 33. 4 retirement benefit. 5 Sec. 2. Section 38-740, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 6 38-740. Return of contributions 7 A. Any A member WHOSE MEMBERSHIP COMMENCED BEFORE JULY 1, 2009 AND who leaves employment other than by retirement or death may elect to receive a 8 9 return of the contributions as follows: 10 1. If the member has less than five years of credited service, the 11 member shall receive the member's contributions. 12 2. If a member has five or more years of credited service, the member 13 shall receive the member's contributions and an amount equal to a percentage of the employer contributions paid on behalf of the member. The percentage 14 15 of employer contributions paid on behalf of the member shall be as follows: 16 5.0 to 5.9 years of credited service, twenty-five per cent. (a) 17 (b) 6.0 to 6.9 years of credited service, forty per cent. (c) 7.0 to 7.9 years of credited service, fifty-five per cent. 18 19 (d) 8.0 to 8.9 years of credited service, seventy per cent. 20 (e) 9.0 to 9.9 years of credited service, eighty-five per cent. 21 (f) 10.0 or more years of credited service, one hundred per cent. 22 3. Interest on the returned contributions as determined by the board. 23 B. A MEMBER WHOSE MEMBERSHIP COMMENCED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2009, AND 24 WHO LEAVES EMPLOYMENT OTHER THAN BY RETIREMENT OR DEATH MAY ELECT TO RECEIVE 25 A RETURN OF THE MEMBER'S CONTRIBUTIONS. IF A MEMBER HAS FIVE OR MORE YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE, THE MEMBER SHALL RECEIVE THE MEMBER'S CONTRIBUTIONS AND 26 27 AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO TWENTY-FIVE PER CENT OF THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS PAID ON 28 BEHALF OF THE MEMBER. 29 C. THE AMOUNT RETURNED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OR B ACCUMULATES 30 INTEREST AT A RATE THAT IS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD. 31 B. D. Withdrawal of contributions with interest constitutes a 32 withdrawal from membership in ASRS and results in a forfeiture of all other 33 benefits under ASRS. 34 C. E. Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, a member 35 who has not received a return of contributions pursuant to this section may 36 combine any two or more periods of service for purposes of determining the 37 member's benefits. 38  $\mathbf{P}$ . If a member receives more than the amount due to a member 39 pursuant to this section, the member shall repay the amount of the 40 overpayment together with interest at the interest rate earned on ASRS 41 investments as reported on a quarterly basis, but not less than the valuation 42 rate established by the board, from the time of overpayment to the settlement 43 of the debt.

3 If any change or error in the records results in any member or beneficiary receiving from ASRS more or less than the member or beneficiary 4 5 would have been entitled to receive if the records had been correct. the board ASRS shall correct the error and as far as practicable shall adjust the 6 7 payments in a manner so that the actuarial equivalent of the benefit to which 8 the member or beneficiary was correctly entitled is paid. The board ASRS 9 shall correct any change or error and shall pay the appropriate monies to a 10 member or beneficiary or shall recover monies from the member or beneficiary 11 if the member or beneficiary is overpaid.
