To Whom it May Concern,

I represent a motor carrier that operates both company owned and inter-modal equipment. My operation is primarily in the Mid-Atlantic region and the inter-modal operation services steamship lines at the ports of New York, Philadelphia PA, Baltimore MD & Norfolk VA.

In 1998, C.T.I. had 126 inspections, 53 of which were performed on C.T.I.'s company owned equipment and 73 on inter-modal equipment. The out of service rate was 23% for my company equipment and 40% for the intermodal equipment.

Of the 40% out of service from my inter-modal operation, 76% was the #2 vehicle, the container chassis. Since this equipment isn't owned by C.T.I., I have no control over the maintenance of these chassis. I feel it's somewhat unfair to hold the motor carrier responsible for the maintenance of equipment it doesn't own and may have it in its possession for 1 day.

I have enclosed, for your review, a detailed breakdown of my findings, including the inspection report numbers, the state where the inspections took place & the date of each inspection.

I hope you find this information useful and I look forward to help make our highways safer.

## In response to the specific auestions.

- 1. 40% Out of service (*Intermodal chassis*)
  - 90% Out of service orders are issued within 24 hours of picking up the container.
- 2. Average 2 violations per inspection on chassis.
- 3. The UIIA is controlled by the owners/providers of the inter-modal equipment.
- 4. N/A
- 5. The same way they hold the carrier responsible for the equipment even if the carrier picked-up the equipment damaged.
- 6. The provider should warrant the equipment for at least 5 days.
- 7. Nothing prevents the driver from walking around a container or trailer.
  - Drivers would have to be trained in the operation & maintenance of the trailer electrical system, breaking system, suspension system and tires (including how to spot a defective re-cap), then the driver would need a full set of tools to repair the equipment. Absolutely not possible.
- 8. Not relevant to safety.
- 9. 100% of the time. The motor carrier has no first hand knowledge of whether the FHWA inspection was made.

- 13. The problem is that no one is checking to see if the current inspections are being made, let alone increasing the number of inspections.
