By the Senior Deputy Chief, Policy Division, Media Bureau:

- 1. Comcast Cable Communications, LLC ("Comcast") has filed a Motion for Extension of Time in which to submit its Answer to the above-captioned program carriage complaint ("Complaint") filed by NFL Enterprises LLC ("NFL").
