Re: Withdrawal Payments For Auction No. 33

Dear Mr. Ittner:

Motorola Spectrum, Inc. ("Motorola"), a participant in Auction No. 33, withdrew two high bids in that auction.¹ Auction No. 38, the subsequent auction for the licenses on which Motorola withdrew high bids in Auction No. 33 has closed.² Therefore, in accordance with the Commission's rules, we are now able to assess final withdrawal payment(s) as described below.

Under the Commission's Rules, a bidder that withdraws a high bid during the course of an auction is subject to a bid withdrawal payment equal to the difference between the amount of the withdrawn bid and the amount of the subsequent winning bid.³ If a high bid is withdrawn on a license that remains unsold at the close of the auction, the withdrawing bidder will be required to make an interim payment equal to three percent (3%) of the net amount of the withdrawn bid.⁴ This payment amount is deducted from any up-front payments or down payments the bidder has deposited with the Commission.⁵ If, in a subsequent auction, that license receives a winning bid in an amount equal to or greater than the withdrawn bid amount, then no final bid withdrawal payment will be assessed, and the bidder may request a refund of the interim three percent (3%) payment.⁶ If, in a subsequent auction, the winning bid for that license is less than the bidder's

withdrawn bid amount, then the bidder will be required to make a final bid withdrawal payment equal to either the difference between the bidder's net withdrawn bid and the subsequent net winning bid, or the difference between the bidder's gross withdrawn bid and the subsequent gross winning bid, whichever is less.⁷

As shown in Attachment A, the winning bids in the subsequent auction were less than Motorola's withdrawn bids. Accordingly, in accordance with Section 1.2104 of the Commission's rules, Motorola is assessed a final withdrawal payment for license MEA049 in the amount of \$3,500.00 and a final withdrawal payment for license MEA051 in the amount of \$1,500.00.9 The Commission has previously deducted an interim withdrawal payment of \$450.00 from the funds on deposit with the Commission. Accordingly, Motorola is ordered to make a payment of \$4,550.00 (\$3,500.00 + \$1,500 - \$450.00) in accordance with the payment instructions in Attachment B within 30 days of the date of this letter.

In Attachment C, the Commission explained that the \$450.00 interim bid withdrawal payment was based on three percent (3%) of the net withdrawn bid on license MEA049 (\$11,000.00 X 3%= \$330.00) and three percent (3%) of the net withdrawan bid on license MEA051 (\$4,000.00 X 3%= \$120.00).
