MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR DRUG
PREVENTION AND TREATMENT PROGRAMS ON TRIBAL LANDS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: drug prevention and treatment
3 programs on tribal lands; exemption

4 A. The sum of \$400,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
5 fiscal year 2007-2008 to the department of health services for drug
6 prevention and treatment programs on tribal lands.

7 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
8 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
9 lapsing of appropriations.
