AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ARIZONA HEALTH CARE COST CONTAINMENT SYSTEM  
ADMINISTRATION FOR EXPANSION OF GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; expansion of graduate medical  
3 education; exemption

4 A. The sum of \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund  
5 in fiscal year 2007-2008 to the Arizona health care cost containment system  
6 administration for expansion of graduate medical education. The  
7 appropriation shall be matched by \$5,900,000 in federal monies.

8 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
9 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
10 lapsing of appropriations.
