AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 1-309; RELATING TO NATIVE AMERICAN RIGHT TO VOTE DAY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 1, chapter 3, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended by adding section 1-309, to read:

4 1-309. Arizona's Native American right to vote day

5 A. JULY 15, IN EACH YEAR, SHALL BE OBSERVED AS ARIZONA'S NATIVE  
6 AMERICAN RIGHT TO VOTE DAY.

7 B. THE GOVERNOR SHALL RECOMMEND THAT TEACHERS AND STUDENTS OF THE  
8 SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE OBSERVE THIS DAY WITH APPROPRIATE EXERCISES AND SHALL  
9 ENCOURAGE CITIZENS TO PURSUE AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE SIGNIFICANCE AND  
10 CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY ARIZONA'S NATIVE AMERICANS.

11 C. ARIZONA'S NATIVE AMERICAN RIGHT TO VOTE DAY IS NOT A LEGAL HOLIDAY.
