Dear Mr. Gilbert:

Hamilton Sundstrand is hereby submitting for EPA's consideration and use, a completed Documentation of Environmental Indicator Determination for the assessment of the Current Human Exposures Under Control. This documentation was completed jointly by UTC / Hamilton Sundstrand and EPA New England - Region 1 and represents our best understanding of current site environmental conditions, site access and relevant standards in making this determination.

This Environmental Indicator submittal replaces our 1999 draft Environmental Indicator Documentation. The 1999 draft documentation was prepared at EPA's request by Hamilton Sundstrand in response to the newly promulgated GPRA, which required EPA to make this assessment at all high priority RCRA Corrective Action sites.


Recent work has been performed at the Windsor Locks facility to bring Current Human Exposures Under Control. In discussions with EPA about current potential exposures, it was determined that the following actions would serve to restrict access to contaminated surface soils to bring current human exposures under control:

- The placement of a cap and 3" of crushed stone at SWMU 30 and SWMU 15 to prevent access to contaminated surface soils.
- The installation of a five-foot high security fence and signs at the facility boundary along Park Road to prevent access to the Watts Pond area. Agreed upon sign language is attached to this document.
- The installation of signs at SWMUs 11, 15, 30. Agreed upon sign language is attached to this document.
- The contractor EH&S program will be updated to reference designated remediation areas and cautions associated with these areas.

These actions will be completed on September 30, 2003. Therefore, it can be concluded that the "Current Human Exposures Under Control" question can be answered in the affirmative. While Hamilton Sundstrand agrees with the conclusion of this determination, we believe some of the conclusions for select media could be eliminated earlier in the process.
