AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR VACCINES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: vaccines: exemption

3 A. The sum of \$200,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
4 fiscal year 2007-2008 to the department of health services for the department
5 to contract with nonprofit entities, community health centers and rural
6 health clinics for outreach and education for vaccines listed on the federal
7 advisory committee on immunization practices recommended immunization
8 schedule for persons who are at least eleven but not more than seventeen
9 years of age, including vaccines for human papillomavirus, tetanus,
10 diphtheria, pertussis and meningococcal.

11 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
12 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
13 lapsing of appropriations.
