AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION TO UPGRADE
THE ARIZONA DISPOSITION REPORTING SYSTEM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: Arizona criminal justice commission:
3 Arizona disposition reporting system upgrade:
4 exemption

5 A. The sum of \$1,700,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
6 in fiscal year 2008-2009 to the Arizona criminal justice commission to
7 upgrade the Arizona disposition reporting system according to the Arizona
8 integrated criminal justice information sharing strategic plan pursuant to
9 section 41-2405, Arizona Revised Statutes.

10 B. The Arizona criminal justice commission shall submit a quarterly
11 report to the governor, the president of the senate, the speaker of the house
12 of representatives and the joint legislative budget committee through 2009 on
13 the expenditure of monies and the progress of the project.

14 C. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
15 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
16 lapsing of appropriations.
