AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS TO INCREASE
UNIVERSITY STUDENT AND FACULTY RETENTION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: university student and faculty
3 retention; exemption

4 A. The sum of \$29,800,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
5 in fiscal year 2007-2008 to the Arizona board of regents for increasing
6 university funding in order to:

- 7 1. Attract and retain superior faculty.
- 8 2. Increase the number of student advisors.
- 9 3. Improve student retention rates.

10 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
11 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
12 lapsing of appropriations.
