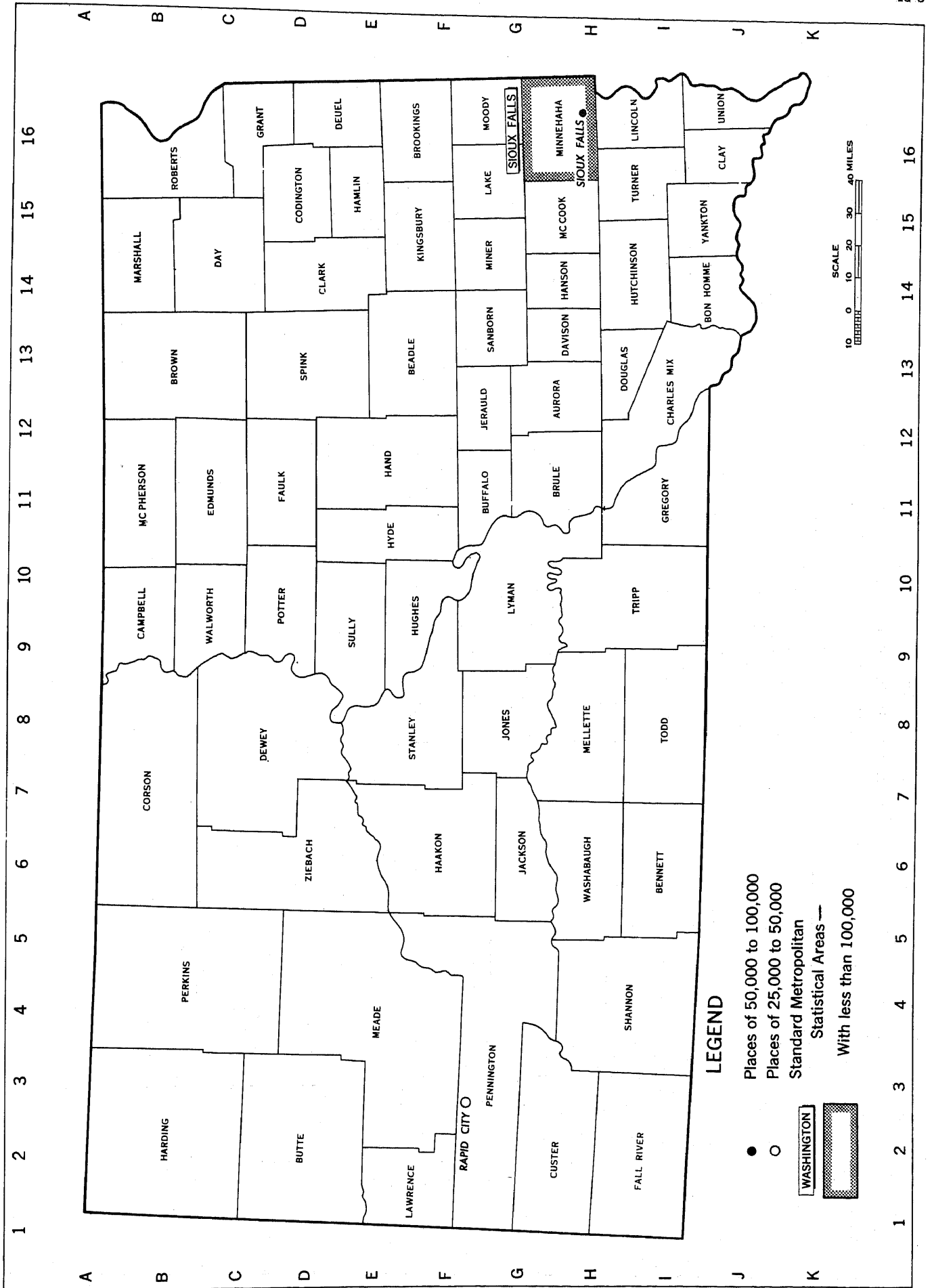

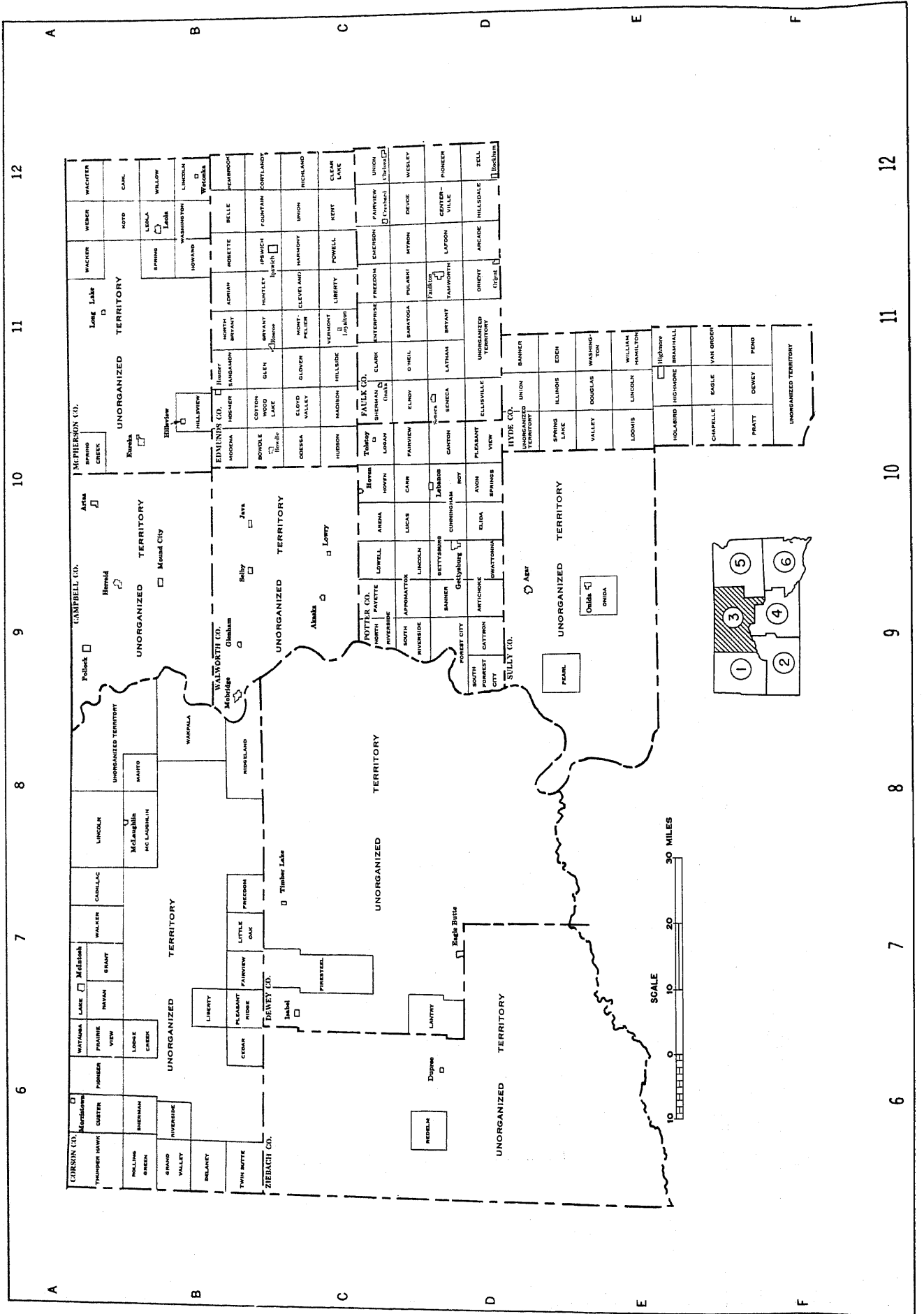

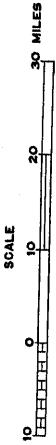
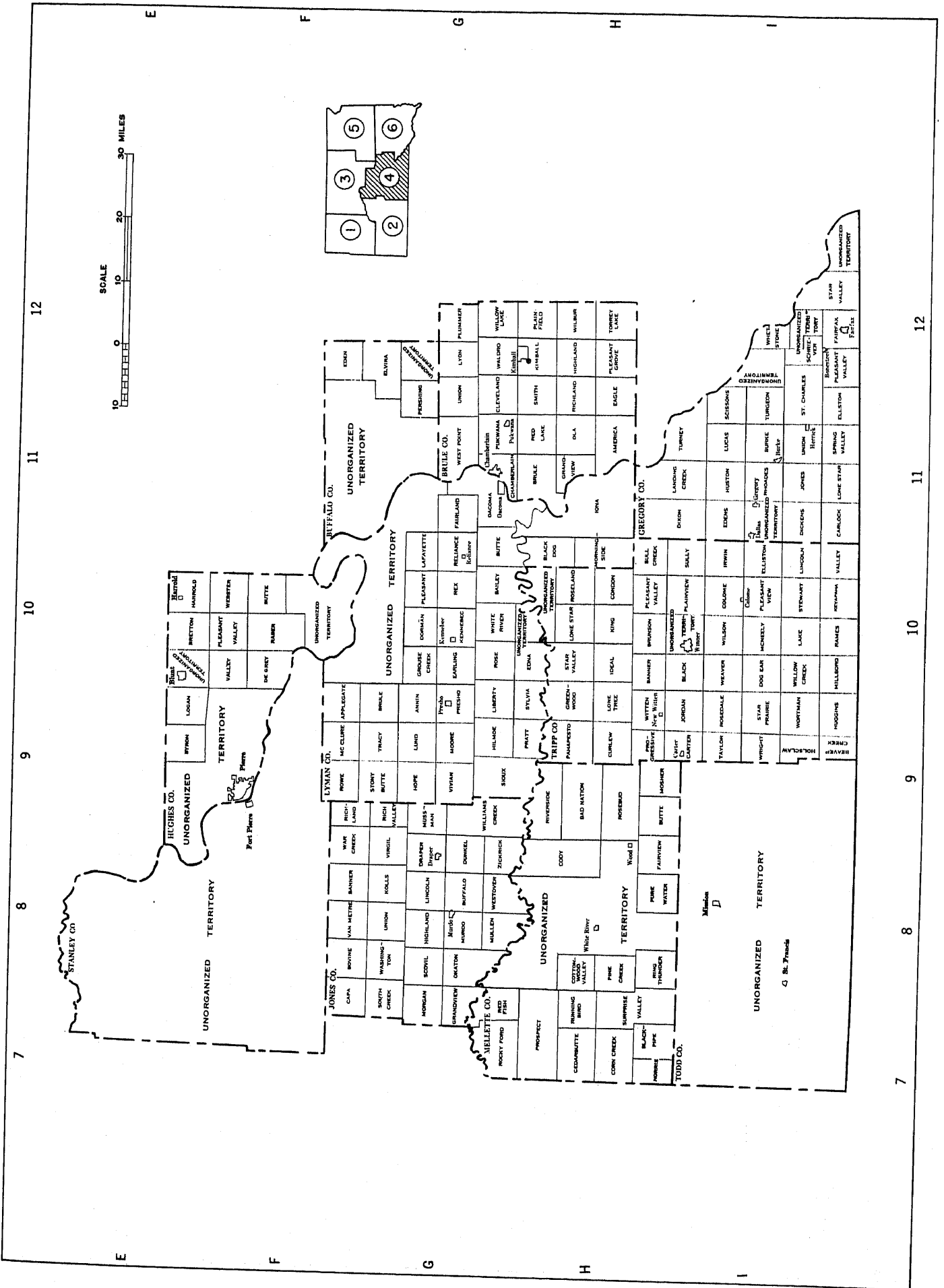

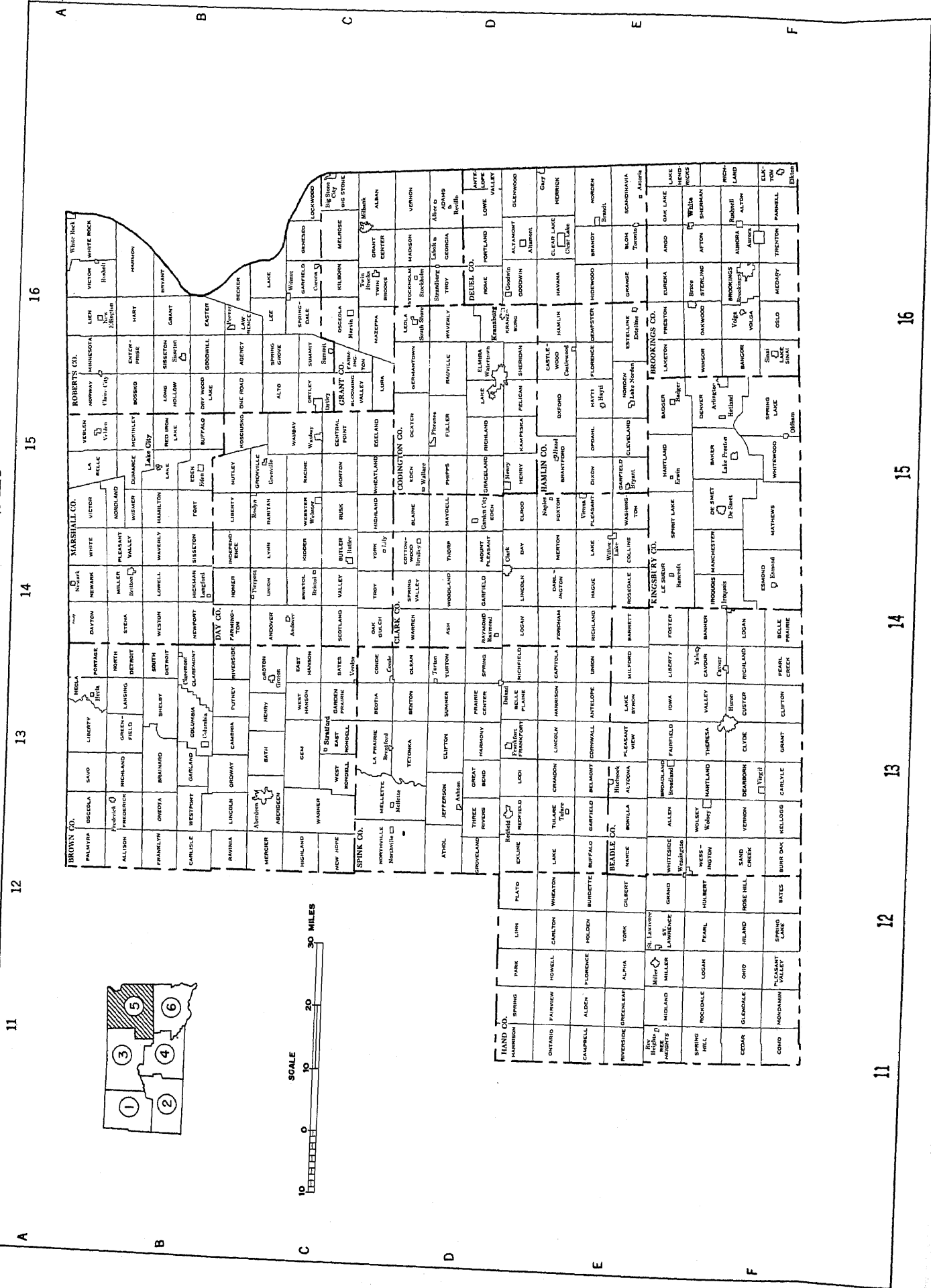
SOUTH DAKOTA—SECTIONS 3 AND 4
MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNSHIPS



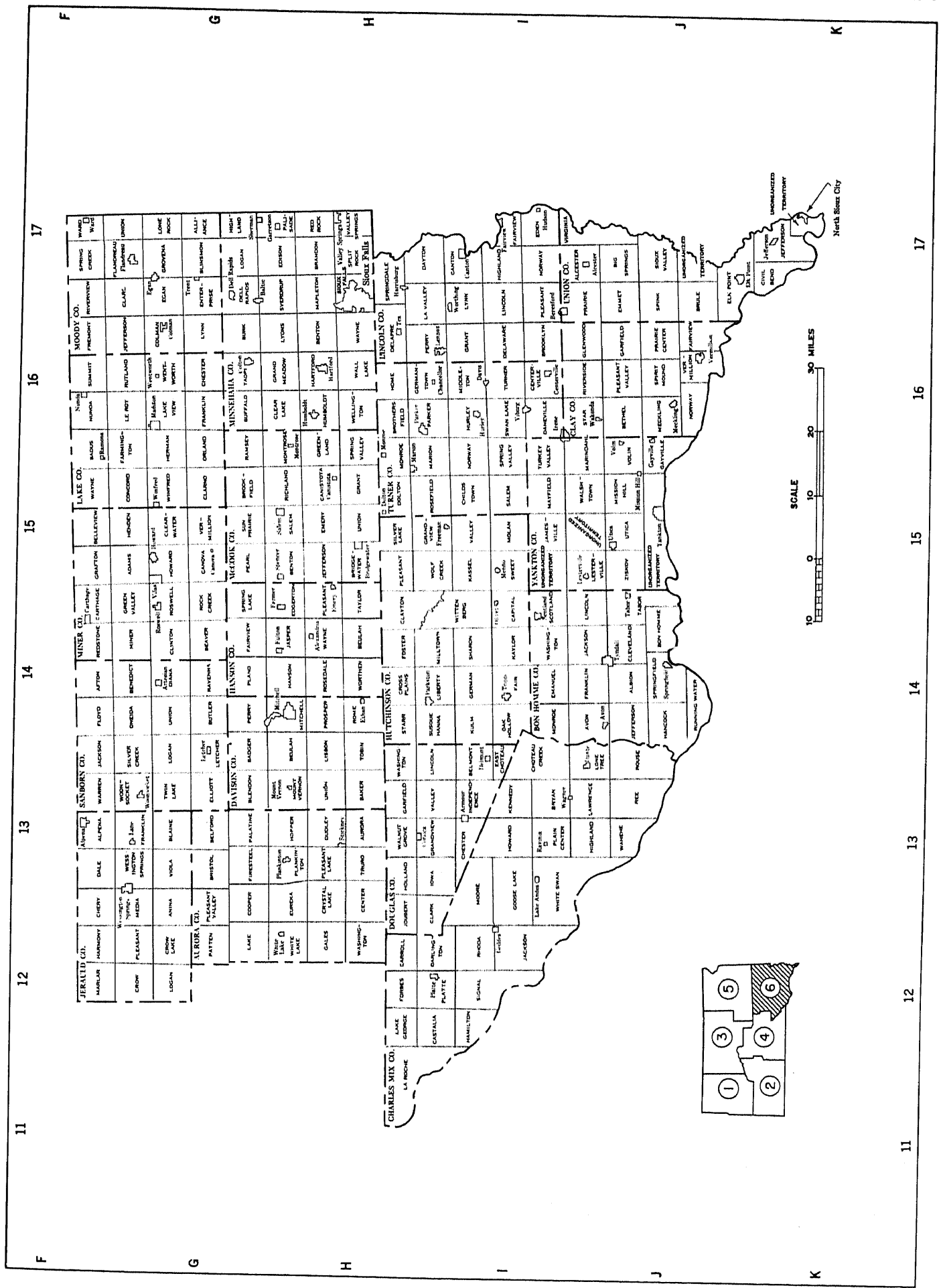

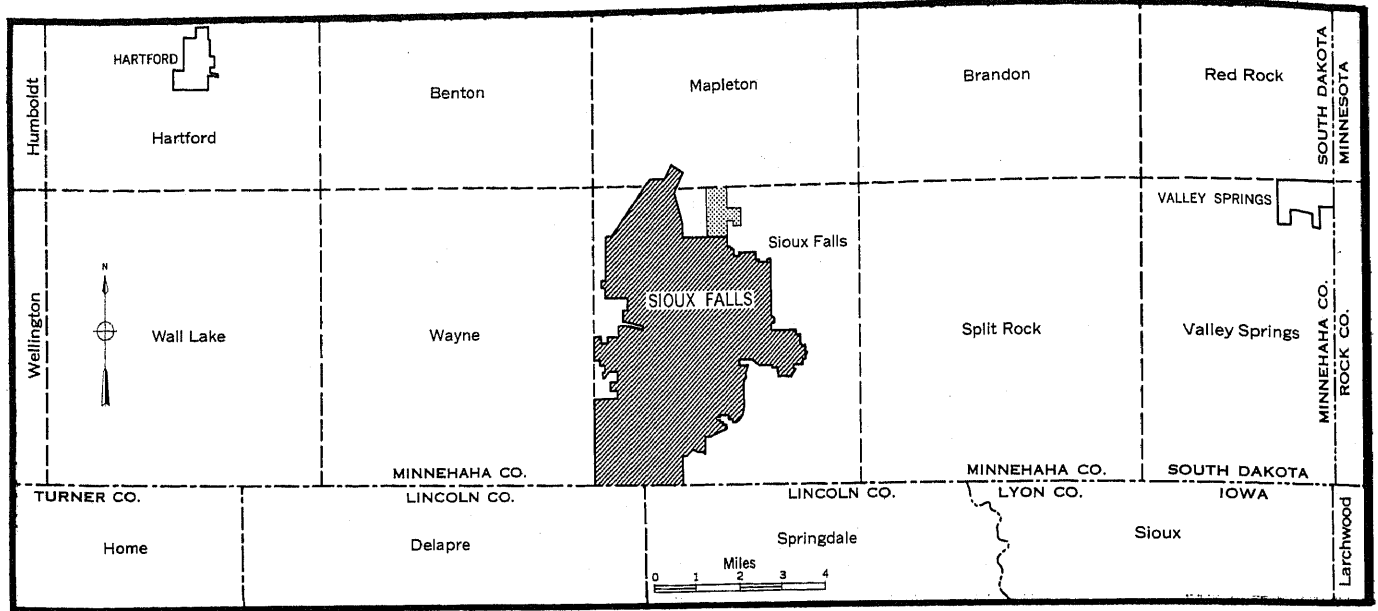
