AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 44, CHAPTER 9, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 22;  
RELATING TO VEHICLE SALES AND LEASES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 44, chapter 9, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended  
3 by adding article 22, to read:

4 ARTICLE 22. VEHICLE SALES AND LEASES

5 44-1378. Contracts for sale or lease of motor homes and  
6 recreational vehicles; definitions

7 A. EVERY CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OR LEASE OF A NEW OR USED MOTOR HOME OR  
8 A NEW OR USED RECREATIONAL VEHICLE SHALL INCLUDE A PERIOD OF TEN BUSINESS  
9 DAYS IN WHICH THE BUYER OR LESSEE MAY RETURN THE MOTOR HOME OR THE  
10 RECREATIONAL VEHICLE TO THE SELLER OR LESSOR FOR A FULL REFUND WITH NO  
11 PENALTIES IMPOSED ON THE BUYER OR LESSEE.

12 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

13 1. "MOTOR HOME" HAS THE SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 28-4301.

14 2. "RECREATIONAL VEHICLE" HAS THE SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION  
15 28-3102.
