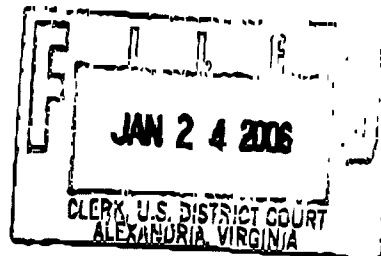

ORDER

Although the government has not yet had a chance to respond to the Defendant's Motion to Compel Discovery (Docket #1467), several of the categories of information are so critical to the issues in this case that the Court can address some of the requests without a response. Moreover, given the increasingly shortening time before the start of the trial, discovery issues must be resolved quickly. Accordingly, Defendant's Motion to Compel Discovery is GRANTED IN PART, and it is hereby

ORDERED that the government immediately provide the Court with a copy of the redacted CIA-OIG report made available to defense counsel as well as a copy of the unredacted report.

the Court needs to be sure that the redactions to the CIA-OIG report are appropriate; and it is further

ORDERED that any and all reports, cables, slides, talking points, memorandum or other documents discussing Moussaoui's arrest, [REDACTED]

immediately; and its is further

ORDERED that any threat assessments, especially for the one-year period before September 11, 2001, are highly relevant and should be produced immediately. Counsel should try to resolve the remaining requests.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record and to the Court Security Officer.
