MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR
INVESTIGATIONS OF COPPER WIRE THEFT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: investigation of copper wire theft
3 cases; exemption

4 A. The sum of \$174,600 is appropriated from the state general fund in
5 fiscal year 2007-2008 to the office of the attorney general for two full-time
6 employees to investigate copper wire theft cases in this state.

7 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
8 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
9 lapsing of appropriations.
