## A bill to amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1996 to deauthorize the remainder of the project at East Boothbay Harbor, Maine

As reported by the Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works on June 1, 1998

CBO estimates that enacting the bill would have no impact on the federal budget. The bill contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.

S. 1532 would deauthorize the remainder of the project for navigation at East Boothbay Harbor in Boothbay, Maine. (No amounts have been appropriated for the project since 1950.) The deauthorization would allow nonfederal facilities to be built within the harbor. Any costs associated with constructing facilities would be incurred voluntarily by nonfederal parties.
