Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona: Section 1. Title 13, chapter 37, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding section 13-3726, to read:

13-3726. <u>Unlawful residency: persons convicted of criminal</u> offenses: exceptions: classification

- A. IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A DANGEROUS CRIME AGAINST CHILDREN AS DEFINED IN SECTION 13-604.01 TO RESIDE WITHIN ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF THE REAL PROPERTY COMPRISING A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE COMMON OR HIGH SCHOOL OR A CHILD CARE FACILITY.
 - B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 1. A PERSON WHO ESTABLISHES THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION OR BEFORE A NEW SCHOOL OR CHILD CARE FACILITY IS LOCATED.
