SENATE BILL 1555

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 37, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 13-3726; RELATING TO RESIDENCY RESTRICTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 37, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 by adding section 13-3726, to read:

4 13-3726. Unlawful residency; persons convicted of criminal
5 offenses; exceptions; classification

6 A. IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A DANGEROUS
7 CRIME AGAINST CHILDREN AS DEFINED IN SECTION 13-604.01 TO RESIDE WITHIN ONE
8 THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FEET OF THE REAL PROPERTY COMPRISING A PUBLIC OR
9 PRIVATE COMMON OR HIGH SCHOOL OR A CHILD CARE FACILITY.

10 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

11 1. A PERSON WHO ESTABLISHES THE PERSON'S RESIDENCE BEFORE THE
12 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION OR BEFORE A NEW SCHOOL OR CHILD CARE FACILITY
13 IS LOCATED.

14 2. A PERSON WHO IS A MINOR.

15 C. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 1
16 MISDEMEANOR.
