AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO NORTHERN ARIZONA UNIVERSITY, ARIZONA STATE
UNIVERSITY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA FOR MEDICAL PROGRAMS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations: university medical programs:
3 exemption

4 A. The sum of \$25,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
5 in fiscal year 2007-2008 for the following:

6 1. \$4,000,000 to Northern Arizona University for health professions
7 expansion.

8 2. \$2,000,000 to Arizona State University for biomedical informatics.

9 3. \$5,250,000 to Arizona State University for the schematic design of
10 the Phoenix biomedical campus.

11 4. \$5,250,000 to the University of Arizona for the schematic design of
12 the Phoenix biomedical campus.

13 5. \$6,000,000 to the University of Arizona for the college of medicine
14 Phoenix program.

15 6. \$1,500,000 to the University of Arizona for the college of pharmacy
16 Phoenix program.

17 7. \$1,000,000 to the University of Arizona for the telemedicine
18 program.

19 B. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are exempt
20 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
21 lapsing of appropriations.
