MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO REPLACE CRIME
EVIDENCE MONIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: FBI monies replacement: exemption

3 A. The sum of \$_____ is appropriated from the state
4 general fund in fiscal year 2007-2008 to the department of public safety for
5 distribution in amounts determined by the department to Arizona native
6 American tribes to replace federal bureau of investigation monies for crime
7 evidence.

8 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
9 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
10 lapsing of appropriations.
