MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AGENCY FOR  
RURAL TELEMEDICINE TECHNOLOGY GRANTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: rural telemedicine grants: exemption

3 A. The sum of \$850,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in  
4 fiscal year 2007-2008 to the government information technology agency for  
5 telemedicine technology grants to rural health clinics and community health  
6 centers.

7 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
8 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
9 lapsing of appropriations.
